

VACCINATION PROVIDER LOCATIONS

A. DCHHS

1. **Dallas College – Eastfield Campus.** DCHHS opened a vaccination site at the Eastfield Campus on October 19, 2021. The site operates Tuesday-Saturday from 9am to 6pm. The site currently has a 500 shot capacity per day.
2. **Fair Park.** Fair Park closed permanent vaccination operations on July 17, 2021. Fair Park hosted pop-up vaccination clinics on Saturdays, until the opening of the State Fair. Vaccinations were provided daily during the State Fair. We are currently working on arrangements to have a continued presence at Fair Park at least once per week.
 - i. **Anticipated start date for Fair Park is 11/20.** Vaccinations will be available for 1st and 2nd doses for children 5-17 and 1st, 2nd, and booster doses for adults.
3. **DCHHS Immunization Clinics.** DCHHS is administering COVID vaccine at 5 of our immunization clinics, including the following locations: (1) 1113 E. Jefferson Boulevard, Suite 200, Dallas, TX 75203; (2) Irving Branch Immunization Clinic, 440 S. Nursery Rd., Irving; (3) John West, 3312 N. Buckner #200; (4) Carrollton Farmers Branch Immunization Clinic, 2774 Valwood Parkway, Farmers Branch, TX 75234 (5) DCHHS Central Office Clinic (2377 N Stemmons Fwy). Appointments are required for these locations. Up to twenty-five appointments are available each day at Jefferson and Irving sites, 40 appointments per day at Central Office and 60 appointments per day at John West, Monday-Friday.
4. **Community Vaccination Clinics.** DCHHS continues to organize community vaccination clinics. Host sites include churches, schools, local businesses, recreation centers, and public libraries. The number of shots administered at a community vaccination clinic has ranged from 15 to 270, with the average being 50-70 shots administered. Community vaccination clinics are promoted on social media and by using a texting vendor to text people who live in the same zip code as the community clinic location. DCHHS is continuing to coordinate with local faith leaders and community leaders to host community vaccination clinics.
 - i. DCHHS is in the process of creating multiple “Vaccine Strike Teams” of 2 nurses and 1 clerk who can work directly with our Community Outreach Director so we can increase the number of COVID vaccination events we are able to do
5. **Local Businesses.** DCHHS is working with DSHS to send mobile teams to local business so employees can receive their vaccination on site.

B. Dallas College

1. All campuses (Brookhaven, Cedar Valley, Eastfield, El Centro, Mountain View, North Lake and Richland) will be open on alternate days until November 15, 2121 from 8:30a – 5:30p. Walk-ins are accepted. Pfizer is offered.

G. Pharmacies and Grocery Stores

1. Kroger - Continuing to provide vaccine daily. Pfizer in all pharmacies. Walk in. Getting through federal pharmacy program. Kroger – approximately 500/week went up to 6700 last week in prior weeks (awaiting additional updates).
2. CVS - Continuing to provide vaccine daily. Different pharmacies are offering different vaccines – either Moderna or Pfizer, but not both. Appointment or walk in.
