

**Examples of Trees & Shrubs
that will comply with Article X
Large Evergreen Shrubs**

Able to reach height of 6 ft upon maturity, 3 ft at time of planting
Use buffer, parking lot screening, foundation planting strip

Upon installation, trees must be single-stem, and 2" or 3" in caliper depending on replacement tree, site tree or street tree classification. Shrubs must be 36 inches (7-9 gallon) in height at the time of installation.
