

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR

SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE CITY OF DALLAS FY 2021-22 ACTION PLAN

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME)

On October 13, 2021, the Dallas City Council authorized **(1)** preliminary adoption Substantial Amendment No. 1 to the FY 2021-22 Action Plan for the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) to (a) reallocate \$976,042.15 in HOME funds balance for Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program (TBRA) to Housing Development Program; (b) reduce the unit production anticipated from 150 units to 108 for TBRA; and (c) increase the Development Loan Program production from 32 to 47; and **(2)** a public hearing to be conducted on December 8, 2021, to receive comments on Substantial Amendment No. 1 to the FY 2021-22 Action Plan for HOME.

The public review and comment period will run through December 8, 2021. On December 8, 2021, a hybrid Dallas City Council public hearing is scheduled to be held to receive comments on Substantial Amendment No. 1 to the FY 2021-22 Action Plan, which will be held not earlier than 1 p.m. Final adoption is scheduled for December 8, 2021. Details of the proposed substantial amendment will be available with the Budget & Management Services – Grant Administration Division and may be reviewed at www.dallascityhall.com.

HUD has provided a waiver to allow virtual public hearings as a means of meeting citizen participation requirements while also striving to contain the virus. Since the local health authorities' recommendation regarding social distancing and limiting public gatherings for public health are still in effect, the proposed public hearing will be conducted as a hybrid meeting.
