Position Purpose

Makes field visits and calculates square footage of areas of commercial and industrial properties and large apartment buildings used for various purposes to ensure that customers are assessed correctly for storm water billing.

Essential Functions

- 1. Visits the field and takes measurements of commercial and industrial properties and determines their uses to establish acreage/square footage for various uses to ensure accurate storm water billing.
- 2. Calculates storm water fees using formulas and the type of use of properties to ensure maintenance of an equitable storm water billing system.
- 3. Researches tax and appraisal district records to verify owners and boundaries of properties to ensure the accuracy of storm water assessments.
- 4. Communicates with the public and answers questions from customers regarding storm water fee assessments to keep them informed of policies and procedures on storm water billing.
- 5. Regular, reliable and punctual attendance is an essential function of the job.
