Position Purpose

Plays and announces classical music programming, news information and promotional spots to provide the community with an enjoyable listening experience.

Essential Functions

- 1. Plays and announces pre-selected classical music, programs and commercial advertisements for the listening audience; announces call letters and identifies station to comply with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations.
- 2. Monitors output of Associated Press (AP) machine and broadcasts appropriate news and weather information to keep listening audience informed.
- 3. Operates audio control console and other broadcast equipment.
- 4. Logs each musical selection played for completion of monthly reports and maintains FCC daily operations log according to procedures.
- 5. Makes programming changes as needed to accommodate time constraints and errors on music log; chooses musical programming for selected time slots.
- 6. Operates studio recording equipment to record materials and mix sound such as voices, music and special effects.
- 7. Researches program material to be used in broadcasting to provide information to the listening audience.
- 8. Writes copy for commercial messages for station's clients; records and produces finished advertising spots for broadcast.
- 9. Answers listeners' phone calls to provide information about station programming; makes appearances at station promotional events.
- 10. Regular, reliable and punctual attendance is an essential function of the job.
