Dallas CERT Radio Training Net Scenarios

Overview

This document provides sample scenarios used when conducting CERT radio operator training. These training scenarios fall into three major categories:

- Search and Rescue (SAR) Scenarios (Sierra Alpha through Sierra Hotel)
- Community Event Scenarios (Echo Alpha through Echo Golf)
- Damage Assessment Scenarios (Delta Alpha through Delta Foxtrot)

The Net Controller will assign each training radio operator a specific training scenario. Upon request for a Status Report, the radio operator will locate the training scenario in this guide and respond via radio procedures appropriate to the designated training scenario.

Phonetic Alphabet

The phonetic alphabet will be used extensively throughout all radio training nets. Below is the full phonetic alphabet.

S - Sierra A - Alpha J - Juliet B - Bravo K - Kilo T - Tango C - Charlie L - Lima U - Uniform V - Victor D - Delta M - Mike E - Echo N - November W - Whiskey F - Foxtrot O - Oscar X - X-ray G - Golf P - Papa Y - Yankee H - Hotel Q - Quebec Z - Zulu I – India R - Romeo

	Your team has treated the victims; all victims are ready for extrication and movement.
	Your team has not found any Dead victims.
	Your Team Lead has stated that all five of your assigned team members are accounted for.
	SECOND CALL
	You have completed the search of the entire building.
	There was one room in the back portion of the building that you could not get into because it was locked.
	You have moved all live victims to Med Ops except for one (1) Delayed.
	You found one (1) Dead victim.
	There is a smoke detector that keeps going off although there are no signs of
	smoke. You have tried to silence the alarm but it will not silence.
	Your Team Lead states all team members are accounted for.

	team members plus yourself, comprising a six-person team.
	There is a Medical Operations area set up outside the warehouse building.
	Your team is approximately 50% done with your initial search of the structure.
	Your team has found two (2) victims who are classified as Immediate, four (4)
	victims who are classified as Delayed, and five (5) victims classified as Minors.
	Your team has treated the victims you have found so far; all victims are ready
	for extrication and movement.
	Your team has not found any Dead victims.
	Your Team Lead has stated that all six of your assigned team members are
	accounted for.
	SECOND CALL
	You have completed the search of the entire building.
	There was an acrid smell in one computer server room. You turned off the
	electricity to the entire building thinking there might be an electrical problem.
	There was one room in the back portion of the building that you did go into
	since it was marked as containing HAZMAT.
	You have extricated and moved all live victims to Med Ops except for two (2)
	Delayed. You are preparing to move them now and should have them out in
	no more than 2 minutes.
	You found one (1) Dead victim.
	Your Team Lead states all team members are accounted for.

Sierra Charlie	INITIAL CALL
	You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a small church. There are three
	team members plus yourself, comprising a four-person team.
	There is a Medical Operations area set up outside the building.
	Your team is approximately 75% done with your initial search of the structure.
	• Your team has found two (2) victims who are classified as Immediate, three (3)
	victims who are classified as Delayed, and nine (9) victims classified as Minors.
	Your team has treated the victims; all victims are ready for extrication and
	movement.
	Your team has not found any Dead victims.
	Your Team Lead has stated that all five of your assigned team members are
	accounted for.
	SECOND CALL
	You have completed the search of the entire church building.
	There were two (2) rooms on the north side of the building that you could not
	get into because they are locked.
	You have moved all live victims to Med Ops except for one (1) Delayed.
	You found two (2) Dead victims.
	Your Team Lead states all team members are accounted for.

Sierra Delta	INITIAL CALL
	You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a small, four story office building.
	There are five team members plus yourself, comprising a six-person team.
	There is a Medical Operations area set up outside the building.
	Your team is has completed two floors in your initial search of the structure.
	• Your team has found two (2) victims who are classified as Immediate, five (5) victims who are classified as Delayed, and three (3) victims classified as Minors.
	Your team has treated the victims you have found so far; all victims are ready for extrication and movement.
	Your team has not found any Dead victims.
	Your Team Lead has stated that all six of your assigned team members are accounted for.
	SECOND CALL
	You have completed the search of the entire office building.
	The sprinkler system was spraying on the third floor and had put out a small
	fire. You turned off the water to the sprinkler system since the fire was out.
	There was one room in the back portion of the building that was marked as
	containing HAZMAT. Unfortunately, one of your team members went into the
	room. The team member has been separated away from the remainder of the
	team and the victims.
	You have extricated and moved all live victims to Med Ops except for one (1)
	Delayed. You are preparing to move this person now and should have them out
	in no more than 1 minute.
	You found one (1) Dead victim.
	Your Team Lead states all team members are accounted for.

	You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a cluster of six homes in a small									
	cul-de-sac. There are seven (7) team members plus yourself, comprising an									
	eight-person team.									
	There is a Medical Operations area set up near the entrance to the cul-de-sac.									
	Your team has completed the initial search of four of the six homes.									
	Your team has found two (2) victims who are classified as Immediate, five (5) it is a share factor of the control of									
	victims who are classified as Delayed, and nine (9) victims classified as Minors.									
	• Your team has treated the victims found so far. Except for one (1) Immediate victim in the very rear of House #1 who requires leveraging/cribbing, all other									
	victims are ready for extrication and movement.									
	Your team found one Dead victim, in House #2.									
	Your Team Lead has stated that one team member is presently unaccounted									
	for.									
	SECOND CALL									
	You have completed the search of six homes.									
	You improvised a lever and cribbing set up and were able to extricate the									
	trapped victim. That person has been moved to Med Ops.									
	All of your Immediate and Delayed victims have been moved to Med Ops. You									
	still have (3) Minor victims who are in your area awaiting movement.									
	You found one (1) Dead victim in the garage behind home #5.									
	Gas was found to be leaking from an outdoor fireplace at home #6. You turned									
	the gas off at the meter near the alleyway.									
	One of your team members slipped and fell. He has a cut on his arm, which									
	you have treated. The team member says he can continue to be part of the									
	team.									
	Your Team Lead has stated that all team members are accounted for.

Sierra Foxtrot	INITIAL CALL									
	• You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a series of eight businesses in a strip shopping mall. There are five (5) team members plus yourself, comprising a six-person team.									
	There is a Medical Operations area set up in the parking lot near the middle of the shopping mall.									
	Your team has completed the initial search of six of the eight businesses.									
	 Your team has found three (3) victims who are classified as Immediate, four (4) victims who are classified as Delayed, and five (5) victims classified as Minors. 									
	• Your team has treated the victims found so far. Except for one (1) Immediate victim near the front of Business #3 who requires leveraging/cribbing, all other victims are ready for extrication and movement to Med Ops.									
	Your team found one (1) Dead victim, in Business #2.									
	 Your Team Lead has stated that two team members are presently unaccounted for. 									
	SECOND CALL									
	You have completed the search of all businesses.									
	You identified a HAZMAT sign at the back door to Business #8, so no one entered this building. From the outside, this structure appears to be only very lightly damaged. You can hear a tapping noise coming from the general direction of the interior of this structure but you cannot identify the source. No voices are heard.									
	The cribbing team arrived and they were able to extricate the trapped victim.									
	That person has been moved to Med Ops.									
	All of your Immediate and Delayed victims have been moved to Med Ops. You									
	still have (6) Minor victims who are in your area awaiting movement.									
	You found one (1) Dead victim in Business #7.									
	 You turned off the gas to Business #7 as one of the team members thought they could smell gas. 									
	Your Team Lead has stated that all team members are accounted for.

Sierra Golf	 INITIAL CALL You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a cluster of eight buildings in a light industrial area. There are seven (7) team members plus yourself, comprising an eight-person team. There is a Medical Operations area set up near the entrance to the industrial area. Your team has completed the initial search of four of the eight buildings. Your team has found three (3) victims who are classified as Immediate, five (5) victims who are classified as Delayed, and ten (10) victims classified as Minors. Your team has treated the victims found so far. Except for one (1) Immediate victim in the very rear of Business #2 who requires leveraging/cribbing, all other victims are ready for extrication and movement. Your team found one Dead victim, in Business #3. Your Team Lead has stated that two team members are presently unaccounted for. 									
	 You have completed the search of all eight buildings. The cribbing crew arrived and extricated the trapped victim. That person has been moved to Med Ops. All of your Immediate and Minor victims have been moved to Med Ops. You have two (2) Delayed victims awaiting movement. You found one (1) Dead victim in Business #5. Gas was found to be leaking from a furnace at Business #6. You turned the gas off at the meter outside the building. One of your team members slipped and fell. He twisted his ankle and cannot walk. The team leader says he cannot continue to be part of the team. Your Team Lead has stated that all team members are accounted for.

	You are supporting a SAR Team assigned to a small school campus with six									
	buildings. There are seven (7) team members plus yourself, comprising an									
	eight-person team.									
	There is a Medical Operations area set up in the parking lot near the entrance to the campus.									
	 Your team has completed the initial search of four of the buildings. 									
	 Your team has found three (3) victims who are classified as Immediate, three 									
	(3) victims who are classified as Delayed, and six (6) victims classified as Minors.									
	 Your team has treated the victims found so far. Except for two (2) Immediate victims located outside of Building #3 who require leveraging/cribbing, all other victims are ready for extrication and movement to Med Ops. Your team found one (1) Dead victim, in Building #2. 									
	 Your Team Lead has stated that one team member is presently unaccounted 									
	for.									
	SECOND CALL									
	You have completed the search of all buildings in the campus.									
	You identified high voltage power lines down on the ground near the back									
	door to Building #5. There is a sound of sparking wires, but nothing seems									
	visible. Your team marked off a perimeter around that building.									
	The cribbing team arrived and they extricated the first trapped victim. That									
	person has been moved to Med Ops. They are working to extricate the second victim, who is your last Immediate.									
	All of your Minor victims have been moved to Med Ops. You still have three									
	(3) Delayed victims who are in your area awaiting movement.									
	You found one (1) additional Dead victim in the swimming pool outside Building #6.									
	Your Team Lead has stated that all team members are accounted for.

Echo Alpha	•	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to roam an area near the main stage
		for an outdoor music festival. There are two (2) team members including yourself.
	•	Your team has just witnessed a male person drop off a backpack about 50 feet
		from the right-hand side of the stage and walk off. The person blended into the
		crowd and has not come back.
	•	The whole scenario seems a little suspicious and needs to be checked out. You
		have looked for nearby police officers or security personnel but cannot see any.
	•	Both of your team members are accounted for.
Echo Bravo	•	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to roam an area near the Start/Finish
		Line of a marathon. There are two (2) team members including yourself.
	•	Your team has just witnessed a male runner falling about 400 yards before the
		Finish Line. The runner was running in a northerly direction.
	•	The runner who fell, Bib Number 07920, complains about a "blown out" knee. He
		cannot get up and walk. The runner is in obvious discomfort.
	•	The runner has requested someone come pick him up and take him for medical
		treatment.
	•	The runner looks to be about 60 years old.

Echo Charlie	•	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to roam an area near the Dignitary
		reviewing stand of a parade. There are two (2) team members including yourself.
	•	Your team has just witnessed a female person place a roll around suitcase about
		100 feet behind the reviewing stand and walk off. The person has not come back.
	•	The whole scenario seems unusual. You have looked for any nearby police officers
		or security personnel but you cannot see any.
Faha Dalta	•	Both of your team members are accounted for.
Echo Delta	•	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to roam an area near the Start/Finish
		Line of a marathon. There are two (2) team members including yourself.
	•	Your team has just witnessed a female runner falling about 300 yards before the
		Finish Line. The runner was running in a westerly direction.
	•	The runner who fell, Bib Number 11402, has a very deep cut on her knee. She is
		laying on the roadway and complains of not being able to get up and even walk. The runner is in obvious discomfort.
	•	The runner has requested medical treatment. You do not have enough gear to
		treat the deep cut.
	•	The runner looks to be about 40 years old.
		The runner says she really wants to finish the race.
	_	Both of your team members are accounted for.

Scenario ID	Scenario Situation and Status
Echo	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to roam an area near the Start/Finish
Foxtrot	Line of a "fun-run" and fund-raising event. There are two (2) team members
	including yourself.
	Your team has just come across a crying male child about 200 yards before the
	Finish Line. The child in on the south side of Harbinger Ave.
	• The child does not appear to be hurt. The boy says his name is Jimmy, he is 4-years
	old, and he is crying because he cannot find his father.
	The child says his father's name is James. The child also says that his mother was
	running in the race and he believes her bib number was 192. Her name is Mommy.
	Your team needs guidance of what to do.
	Both of your team members are accounted for.
Echo Golf	You are supporting an Event Team assigned to an intersection (Jones Parkway and
	State Hwy 152) about two miles from the finish of a 50-mile bicycle race. There are
	three (3) team members including yourself.
	Your team has just witnessed three cyclist fail to navigate the intersection and
	crash off the race course.
	One male racer, Bib Number 9902, slid under a pickup and is trapped underneath
	the vehicle which cannot be moved. The racer is in extreme discomfort.
	The other two racers, one male and one female, have minor scrapes and bruises.
	Their bib numbers are 861 and 1241. Their bikes are not ridable. These racers
	request transport to the finish line.
	All of your team members are accounted for.

Damage Assessment Scenarios

Scenario Situation and Status

- You are supporting a Damage Assessment Team assigned to a small neighborhood of 16 homes.
- It is raining lightly at the time and it is approximately 35 degrees with the wind out of the North at 15 mph.
- There are four (4) members in your team. You and a driver (Team Lead) have stayed in a vehicle while a squad of two members goes down the street on foot to assess the condition of the homes.
- The squad has reported the conditions of homes to you using GMRS radios.
- Your team has completed eight (8) of the homes in your assigned neighborhood.
- You now have a compiled status report for the completed portion of your assigned neighborhood, which is to be relayed to the Zone Command net control radio operator (see below completed forms for compiled status reports).
- All members of your team have been accounted for.
