

The Miller and Stemmons Historic District lies near the center of the suburb now known as Oak Cliff in the City and County of Dallas in North Texas. It is about seven blocks west of the original Oak Cliff subdivision platted in 1887. The rectilinear historic district comprises approximately 124 acres, roughly bounded by Neches Street to the north, Woodlawn Avenue to the west, and Elsbeth Street to the east. Davis Street, a thoroughfare to the Dallas-Fort Worth Turnpike, forms the south boundary of the gridiron tract and is one of the area's major commercial arteries. Bishop Avenue, the principal street and originally called Cleveland Drive, bisects the district north to south and features some of the neighborhood's oldest buildings. The historic district consists primarily of 1- and 2-story single-family residential buildings dating from 1910 to the late 1930s and post-1920 multiple-family apartment buildings. Most of the buildings are wood frame or brick and reflect early 20th century architectural influences and forms such as the bungalow and four-square. Of the district's 381 properties, 243 are Contributing and 138 are Noncontributing.

The Miller and Stemmons Historic District lies on relatively flat, high terrain that easily accommodates a formal gridiron plan. Bishop Avenue, the principal thoroughfare originally called Cleveland Drive, bisects the district in a north-south direction. Three other streets run north-south while four run east-west. The district consists of approximately 22 rectangular blocks accumulating to approximately 124 acres. A few stately Elm trees shade the district and probably date to early years of development. Other species of trees, various shrubs, and grassy lawns complete the landscaping. Vacant lots are rare. Most buildings face east and west and are densely concentrated on relatively narrow lots with nominal side yards (Photo 1). Outbuildings are almost exclusively garages of frame construction, either 1-story or 2-story. Many of the original auto garages remain, although in far fewer numbers than primary structures.

Early 20th century bungalows and four-square houses comprise the majority of buildings in the district. Many of these feature early craftsman decorative details but some sport Classical Revival columns and porches. Good examples include the bungalows at 705 to 727 Woodlawn Street (c. 1920-25, Site Nos. L6-6326 to L6-6331, Photo 2) and the four-square at 835 North Haines Street (c. 1920, Site No. K6-6470, Photo 3). Most of the 1- and 2-story buildings in the district have wood porches, brick pier and beam foundations, and frame construction with either weatherboard or 117 siding.

Several 1920s multiple-family apartment buildings are interspersed among the single-family dwellings, with a particularly high concentration along N. Bishop Avenue (Photo 4). Most of these are 2-story brick buildings covered with large hipped roofs covered with asphalt shingles. In some cases, these buildings also have rear 1- and 2-story garages.

One institutional building, a fire station, is at 602 North Bishop in the district. This 2-story, brick building faces west on the corner of Bishop and West Davis. Two large vehicular openings highlight the first floor with three sets of paired 6/1 windows on the second. A continuous pent roof awning covered with red tile shades the windows on the west and south. The building is largely intact with some modifications to the vehicular enclosures on the first floor.

Noncontributing buildings were largely built after 1944 and are 1- or 2-story, flat-roofed office or multiple-family apartments located along either Bishop Avenue and Elsbeth Street. These buildings are seldom setback the same depth and are generally larger in scale than the earlier buildings. The street pattern consequently has an inconsistent rhythm in some sections.

The Miller and Stemmons Historic District is an excellent collection of domestic buildings that date primarily from c. 1910 through the late 1930s. The district represents the typical suburban neighborhood that developed in Oak Cliff during the early 20th century and is linked with the historic context *Suburban Development in Oak Cliff, Dallas, 1887-1944*. The period of significance extends from the construction of the oldest extant buildings in the district in 1910 to 1944, fifty years ago. The district is eligible for inclusion in the National Register under Criterion C in the area of Architecture at a local level. Although similar developments survive in the Oak Cliff, few retain their integrity to such a noteworthy degree.

The Miller and Stemmons Addition, part of a neighborhood known as the "Kidd Springs," developed near early subdivided property in the Oak Cliff area. The principal focus for the residential development was a collection of natural springs, Kidd Springs, roughly two blocks west. The springs became quite popular in the early 20th century and at one point boasted a recreational center and related properties. The springs area later became a public park.

Miller and Stemmons was originally part of the Hillside Addition, platted in 1893, but that subdivision never fully developed. When the City of Dallas annexed Oak Cliff in 1903, the Hillside Addition area attracted new interest. T. Scott Miller, Jr. and Leslie A. Stemmons, along with F.M. Haines, J.S. Ballard, Mrs. A.B. Stemmons and Mrs. R.S. Stemmons filed a plat with the Dallas County Clerk's Office on December 15, 1903 for the Miller and Stemmons Addition. The new developers redrew the lots and blocks of the former Hillside Addition into a gridiron plan oriented to the cardinal directions.

The Miller and Stemmons Addition was initially promoted as an affluent neighborhood, as evidenced by the more substantial houses on Bishop Avenue. This street was particularly popular because it was within sight and walking distance of the streetcar line. Consequently, most of the Addition's early development occurred along Bishop Avenue. The brick fire station on the south end of Bishop anchored the development and provided an essential neighborhood service (c. 1915, Site No. L6-6626, 602 North Bishop Avenue, Photo 5, 6) As a result, prominent doctors, lawyers, and business leaders soon built houses in the area. The Kessler Park subdivision, part of this multiple property nomination, was the only other subdivision in Oak Cliff that competed directly with the socioeconomic appeal of Miller and Stemmons.

The house at 729 North Bishop (c. 1920, Site No. L6-6570, Photo 7) is an example of a more substantial house typical of that owned by wealthier residents. The subtle combination of Prairie School details, including an emphasis on horizontal lines drawn by its wide front porch, and craftsman detailing imply an appreciation for popular architecture of the early 20th century. This house is in contrast to one at 811 Bishop with its Classical Revival influences and Doric columns (c. 1910, Site No. L6-6572, Photo 7). Both of these architectural expressions were popular during the first and second decades of this century.

While the grand houses are important, the district's architectural significance stems primarily from the abundance 1920s and 1930s bungalows and four-square houses. Because development occurred slowly along Woodlawn, Haines, and Madison streets, houses on these streets display features associated with the bungalow architecture from the 1910s to the 1930s (1922 Sanborn Map, Dallas City Directories). This reflected the necessary transformation of the exclusive development to one that catered principally to the middle class.

Most of the bungalows feature low-pitched roofs with multiple gables, wide porches trimmed with craftsman brackets and columns and various types of wood siding. Other craftsman details include the wide eave overhang and square columns seen on the bungalow at 705 North Haines (c. 1925, Site No. L6-6458, Photo 8). Masonry veneered bungalows in Miller and Stemmons illustrate a high level of craftsmanship, as illustrated by 839 North Madison (c. 1920, Site No. K6-6690, Photo 9). Some less-typical bungalow features include side-gable orientation or Classical Revival detailing.

The neighborhood's numerous four-square dwellings and variants often have Prairie School influences, such as a low-pitch hipped roof and other details that emphasize horizontal lines, as seen at 709 North Haines (c. 1920, Site No. L6-6459, Photo 10). Regardless of ornamentation, however, four-square houses in the district share features characteristic of that type: namely, two stories high with a hipped roof dormer and a 1-story porch that is often extended to create a porte cochere.

Most of the historic apartments are four-unit brick veneer buildings, such as 702 North Bishop (c. 1925, Site No. L6-6631 Photo 11). Many of these are similar in form and detailing to the four-square dwellings. Apartments built after the 1920s are generally larger, demonstrated by the apartment building at 839 North Bishop (c. 1935, Site No. L6-6576, Photo 12).

The neighborhood declined in the years following World War II and many of the houses were leased to tenants. By the 1960s, when much of Oak Cliff was experiencing considerable economic decline, many single-family houses were converted into multi-family apartments. New residential construction often detracts from the historic fabric of the community with unsympathetic details such as decorative ironwork, burglar bars like that at 800 Woodlawn, or vinyl siding. Other intrusions include 1- and 2-story commercial buildings with setbacks and designs out of character with the historic fabric of the neighborhood.

During the 1980s, the area was rediscovered. A small number of single-family houses built in the 1980s indicated a reversal of mid-20th century trends to overdevelop the neighborhood. Although these new buildings do not contribute to the historic character of the district, their scale and placement respect the character established by the historic development. In addition, ongoing restoration activities such as the commercial reuse of the fire station have helped reclaim many historic buildings.

Today, the Miller and Stemmons Historic District consists of diverse socioeconomic fabric with a mixture of architectural styles, ethnic groups, income levels, and age ranges. The district maintains its historic integrity through retention of substantial historic fabric, commonality of domestic architectural types and stylistic influences, and relatively consistent development patterns. The forms and architectural detailing found in the historic district are evident elsewhere in Oak Cliff, however this particular collection of resources retains a unusually high degree of integrity and is eligible under Criterion C for its architecture at the local level.

Thence west along Davis Street and continuing until reaching the southwest corner of Block D/3437, lot 7A, City of Dallas. JUSTIFICATION OF BOUNDARIES - MILLER AND STEMMONS HISTORIC DISTRICT

The Miller and Stemmons Historic District includes a large section of the Miller and Stemmons Addition established in 1903 according to plat map records on file at the Dallas County Courthouse. Zang Boulevard to the east and Davis Street to the south are physical barriers that separate the historic district from surrounding neighborhoods. These thoroughfares are lined with, for the most part, commercial and office buildings which contrast sharply to the historic residential character of the district. Area immediately north of Neches Street (the northern boundary), although part of the Miller and Stemmons Addition, includes commercial, office and institutional buildings. The western boundary extends along an alley that runs between Woodlawn Avenue and Cedar Hill Road. Property

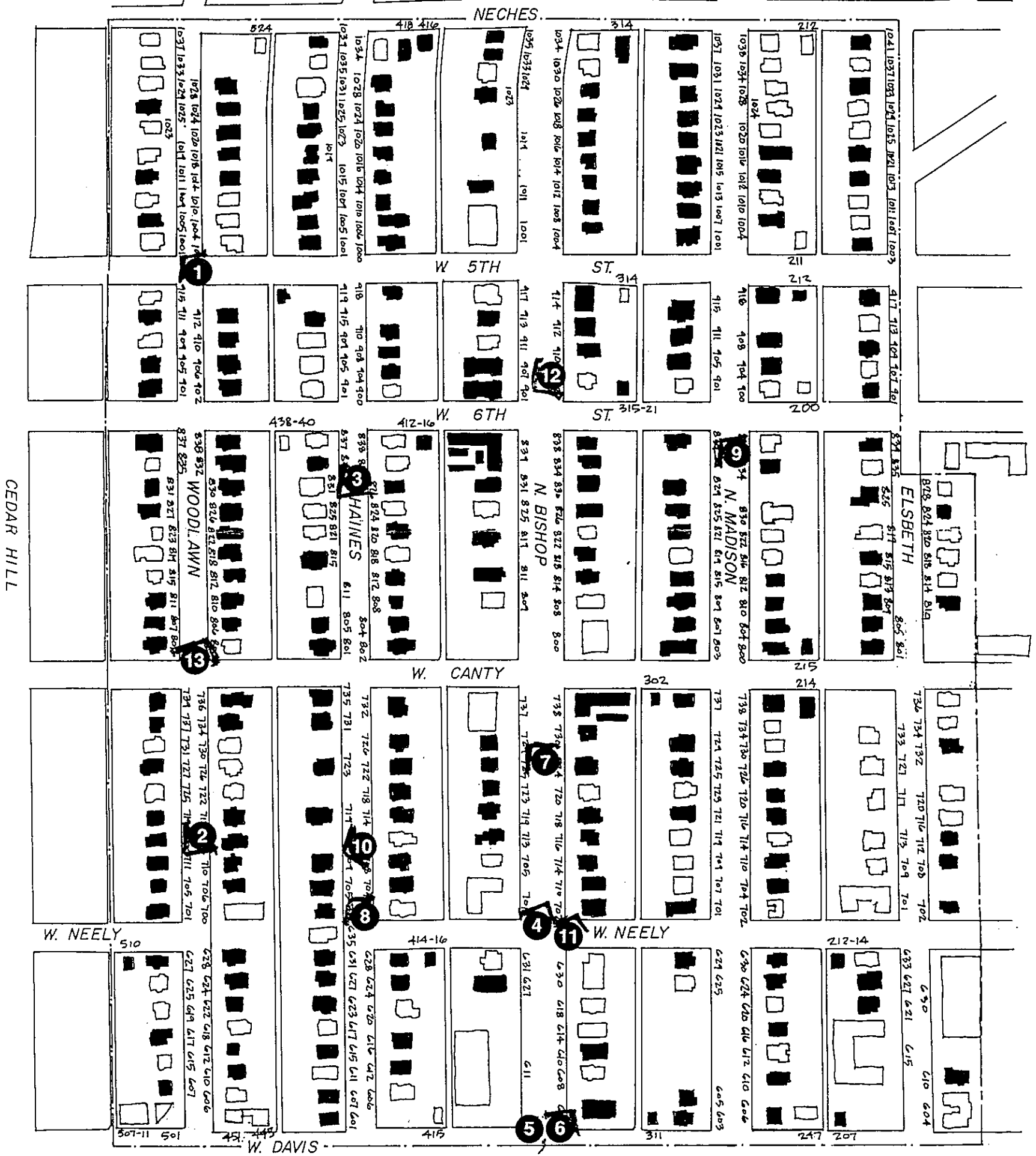
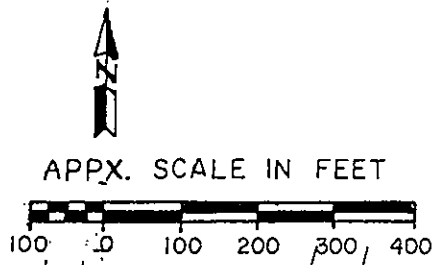
