#### About the grant

The Texas Parks and Wildlife, Community Outdoor Outreach Program Grant provides funding to local governments and non-profit organizations for programming that introduces target populations to environmental and conservation programs as well as Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) mission oriented outdoor activities.

### Requirements of the grant

Organizations must:

Target underserved audiences:

- Ethnic minorities
- Females
- Low income
- Physically/Mentally challenged
- Youth

Conduct outdoor education and programming





The Dallas Park and Recreation Department was awarded nearly \$50,000 of reimbursement funds through the CO-OP grant to provide a minimum of 360 participants with a new outdoor/nature-based program. Dallas youth will now have access to the six (6) core areas:

- Camping
- Geocaching
- Jr. Archery
- Jr. Angler
- Mountain Biking
- Nature Photography
