6. City employee Randal Hawley will address the Board on his disagreement with the qualifications established for the Environmental Coordinator position.
7. Update on FY 09-10 budget and Reduction-in-Force initiatives.
8. **Hear the grievance appeal of Dallas Fire-Rescue Lt. Robin Gerdes in which she claims that the Civil Service Department violated the Code of Rules and Regulations of the Civil Service Board, Rule VIII Conduct of Examinations, Sec. 2 that states in part "All examinations shall be impartial, fair, and practical and designed to test the relative qualifications and fitness of applicants to discharge the duties of the particular position which they seek to fill." Lt. Gerdes claims this rule was violated by not allowing her to continue testing after she was disqualified for failing to stop writing after time was called. She alleges that she was not given the benefit of an investigation into this action. Lt. Gerdes claims that she should have been allowed to continue testing because another candidate was allowed to do so in another test.**
