

Irrigation System Certificate of Completion

This certificate of completion must be presented to the Irrigation Inspector prior to the issuance of a final inspection. This certificate will be kept as a part of the inspection records for this project. The Licensed Irrigator must sign date and seal with his/hers irrigator seal issued by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (30 TAC §§344.40.43)



The following requirements have been completed and / or provided to the property owner:

- A written warranty (30 TAC §§344.72)
- Maintenance, Alteration or Repairs-List of materials used and any warranty if provided. (30 TAC §§344.72 (c))
- A "Final walk through" with the owner or owner's representative and explained operation of the system (30 TAC §§344.63 (1))
- Maintenance check list which includes the following items: **(New Installation)** (30 TAC §§344.63 (2))
 - (A.) Manufacturer's Manual for automatic controller.
 - (B.) Seasonal (spring, summer, fall, winter) watering schedule
 - (C.) List of components, such as the nozzle, or pump filters, or other components that require maintenance and the recommended frequency for service.
 - (D.) The statement "This Irrigation system has been installed in accordance with all applicable state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and orders,. I have tested the system to determine that it has been installed according to the Irrigation Plan and is properly adjusted for the most efficient application of water at this time."
 - (E.) A permanent water proof sticker attached to the automatic controller with the following information.
 - i. Irrigator's Name
 - ii. License Number
 - iii. Company Name
 - iv. Telephone Number
 - v. Warranty Period Dates From: _____ To: _____
 - (F.) As Installed Irrigation Plan

By signing, dating and affixing my TCEQ issued Irrigator's Seal to this Certificate of Completion for Irrigation system, I am certifying that I am in full compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 344, Rules for Landscape Irrigation and Chapter 54, "Dallas Plumbing Code," and Chapter 57, "Dallas One- and Two-Family Dwelling Code," "Appendix J, Standards for Designing, Installing and Maintaining Landscape Irrigation Systems.
