

The Dallas Police Department includes several Divisions in strategic locations throughout the City.

| <b>Patrol Operations</b>                      | Seven Patrol Divisions geographically located to provide continuous patrol and investigative operations; Central Business District; Police Storefronts equipped with police cruisers and support vehicles to conduct patrol operations and follow-up investigations.  | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Air emissions, spills, noise, injuries, storm water / surface discharges.                         |
| <b>Training</b>                               | Academies for new recruits and in-service officers; Firearms Training Center (pistol, rifle, and shotgun ranges, administrative and support buildings).   | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Air emissions, surface contamination, spills, exposures, noise, storm water / surface discharges. |
| <b>Homeland Security / Special Operations</b> | Tactical units, Mounted, Canine, and Explosive Ordnance Squads with associated stables, kennels, and administrative buildings to include canine operations at Love Field. Helicopter Unit (aircraft hanger, administrative building, take-off/landing pad ) designed to maintain the Department's fleet of helicopters in support of continuous operations. | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Air emissions, surface contamination, spills, exposures, noise, storm water / surface discharges. |
| <b>Support Services</b>                       | Police Auto Pound – Fifty-plus acre facility conducting continuous vehicle intake and impound operations. Property Unit - Facility designed to receive, catalogue, and store found and /or confiscated property and items marked as evidence in support of police investigations.   | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Surface contamination, spills, exposures, storm water / surface discharges.                       |
| <b>Crime Scene Response Unit Lab</b>          | Consists of a police crime lab designed to preserve and analyze material obtained from crime scenes in support of continuous criminal investigations.   | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Surface contamination, spills, exposures, storm water / surface discharges.                       |
| <b>Communications/Detention Services</b>      | Conducts continuous police dispatching operations; conducts detention services in the county's detention facility.  | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Exposures/ injuries, surface contamination.   |
| <b>Police Quartermaster Section</b>           | Stores and supplies department personnel with uniforms and equipment.   | <i>Significant Aspects:</i> Exposures/ injuries, surface contamination.   |
