### Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Storm Water Multi-Sector General Permit

The No Exposure Certification (NEC) for the facility listed below was received on February 10, 2010. The intent to obtain a conditional exclusion from permit requirements by certifying that there is no exposure of industrial materials or activities to precipitation or runoff, as allowed in the Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) storm water multi-sector general permit TXR050000, is acknowledged. Your facility's TPDES multi-sector storm water general permit number is:

Coverage Effective: February 7, 2010

TCEQ's storm water multi-sector general permit requires that facilities authorized under this general permit based on having no exposure of industrial activities to ensure that industrial activities and materials are isolated from storm water and storm water runoff by storm resistant shelters. As a facility authorized to discharge under the storm water multi-sector general permit, all applicable terms and conditions related to this conditional exclusion must be complied with to maintain coverage and avoid possible penalties. If this facility changes operating or management practices so as to result in exposure of industrial activities to storm water, then the operator must obtain permit coverage to discharge storm water before implementing the changes that result in exposure of industrial activities to storm water runoff.
