Review of Public Meetings to date and schedule of future Townhalls

- Staff provided an overview of the engagement schedule and meetings for 2024 Bond Program. Staff’s update also included information on 2024 Bond Program survey results.
- Committee asked staff to work ITS to update the Office of Bond and Construction Management (BCM) website to make inclusive on the City’s main webpage for easier accessibility by the public. Staff committed to working with ITS to address accessibility of BCM webpage.

- Chair asked Committee to publicize and share information regarding 2024 Bond Program within personal and communal network.

Technical Briefing 1 – Streets 101

- Committee discussed the inclusion of a public comment period during next Community Bond Task Force meeting.
- Staff requested the addition of a Community Bond Task Force Meeting in July for subcommittees to provide detailed status updates and reports. Staff provided a poll via email for Committee members to select best option amongst group. Staff would provide an update via email on most popular option and will plan accordingly.
- Staff from the Department of Public Works briefed the Committee on the City's streets, technical criteria qualifications, and costs associated with various types of repairs.
- Committee asked questions regarding PBW's process in which projects are evaluated for repair and reconstruction as well as the material used to make repairs to streets. Staff provided information on the City's annual Infrastructure Management Plan (IMP).
- Staff provided an overview of what functions fall under Department of Public Works and Department of Transportation.
- Staff solicited the Committee's feedback on where and how equity should be incorporated within the allocations for streets' related projects within the 2024 Bond Program.
