



City of Dallas Nonprofit Public Improvement Program

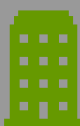
The Nonprofit Public Improvement Program is provided by the City of Dallas through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Design (HUD) - Community Development Block Grant. The program provides grants for capital improvements at Dallas nonprofits.

How to Apply

- A Notice of Funding Available (NOFA) will be available in the summer and funds will be available for use in the fall

Qualifications include:

- Be a 501(3)(c) organization
- Be located in the city of Dallas
- Serve residents of the city of Dallas
- Continue to serve low- and moderate-income persons or an eligible population for at least 5 years after receiving the grant (eligible populations include: abused children, elderly persons, battered spouses, homeless persons, Severely disabled adults, illiterate adults, persons with AIDS, migrant farm workers)
- Have been in operation for at least 6 years prior to applying
- Provide agency financial information for the most recent 5 years
- Provide a match of 25% of the cost of the total project through:
 - Cash sources such as banks, lenders, or other sources, or
 - Non-cash sources such as in-kind donations, pro-bono services, and volunteer hours (note: in-kind donations must be valued at current fair market value, recorded, verifiable, and necessary to complete the project—more information [here](#)).
- Comply with HUD regulations such as [Section 3](#), [Davis-Bacon](#), and [Environmental Reviews](#)
