St. Jude Center- Park Central





The St. Jude Center Park Central (SJC-PC), located at the junction of IH-635 and US-75, is a repurposed four-story hotel that offers long-term, transitional, and permanent supportive housing, alongside comprehensive services. Equipped with elevators, sprinklers, and over 180 rooms for individuals facing homelessness and housing insecurity in Dallas County, the center hosts residents participating in the ESG and HOME-ARP Rapid Rehousing funded services. These efforts blend Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) with transitional housing.

SJC-PC aids individuals over the age of 18 with transitioning from local shelters or similar environments. The program also incorporates wraparound case management services to assess, comprehend, and address the unique needs of each resident. St. Jude provides a space for community partners, like Parkland, MetroCare, and IPS, to provide on-site behavioral health and medical health services to highly vulnerable residents who may not have access to care if it were not provided on-site. Also, Catholic Charities Dallas operates a food pantry at SJC-PC that is open to residents of the property along with those in the community in need of nutritious, free groceries.

About

St. Jude Center - Park Central is housing for the chronically and temporarily homeless with 180 efficiency apartments. According to the Metropolitan Dallas Homeless Alliance 2020 Point-in-Time count, over 4,000 homeless individuals reside in Dallas and Collin Counties. Availability and costs of rental or owned property in the Metroplex continue to rise creating tens of thousands of housing-insecure individuals and families. COVID and other economic pressures have exacerbated the problem.

Three-Phase Impact

Three phases of implementation for maximum impact

COVID19 Relief Housing for COVID19 displaced residents of Dallas County Three meals a day for all residents and personalized case management "Graduate" residents to independent living environments Lessening Homelessness Permanent housing for formerly foster children, veterans and homeless individuals from local Fully-equipped efficiency suites with full kitchens and private bathrooms Continuation of individual case management, including job skills training **Community Outreach** Shelter and housing intake/referral for prospective residents.

Catholic Charities Dallas Homelessness and Housing Services

This second housing facility comes after the success of St. Jude Center on Forest Lane, Catholic Charities' first housing facility with 104 apartments. The Forest Lane Center provides permanent supportive housing for seniors with onsite case management services. Residents are provided with many opportunities to build healthier lives through housing stabilization, thriving towards independence. 22 residents have graduated from the program and in FY20, 115 people were served and 96% of residents remain housing stabilized after 90 days.

St Jude's provides a safe, secure, and dignified home for previously homeless individuals. The center is possible through the collaboration of government and non-profit agencies to provide services that support the whole person. This unique environment meets the needs of the residents and achieves much needed housing units for Dallas. I am proud this model has been embraced by District 13 neighbors and has been a benefit to the entire community.


