

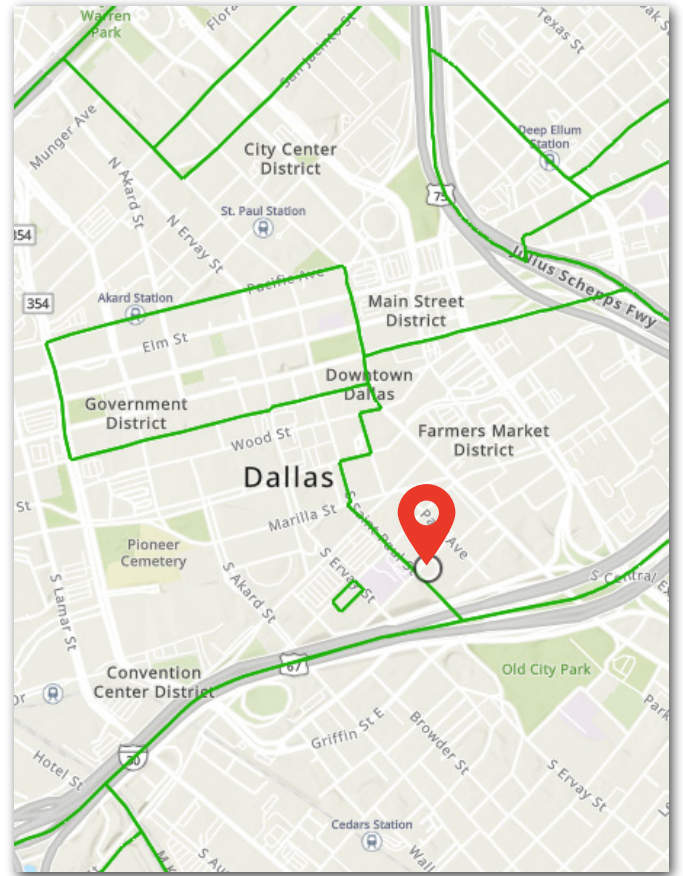
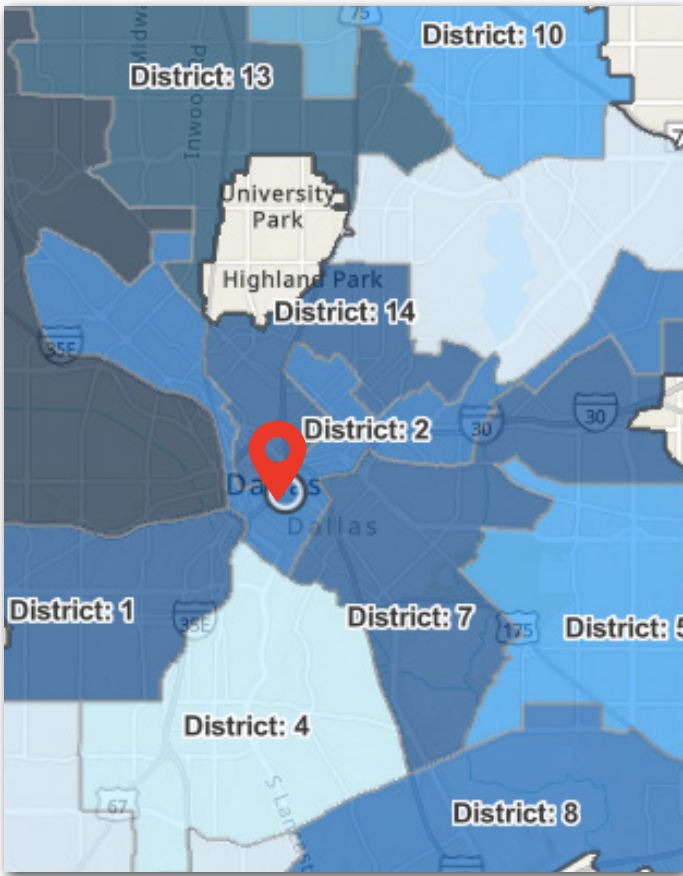
The Bridge

The Bridge Homeless Assistance Center is a countywide, multi service homeless recovery campus that delivers comprehensive, low barrier services to individuals experiencing homelessness in Dallas.



Located in downtown Dallas, the facility serves as a centralized, collaboratively operated service hub, offering emergency shelter, basic needs, coordinated entry assessments, behavioral health and medical supports, and individualized case management.

Through its integrated service model and partnerships with public agencies and nonprofit providers, The Bridge facilitates a structured pathway toward long-term stability, permanent housing, and sustained self-sufficiency. The Center's operations are designed to enhance safety, improve service accessibility, and support positive outcomes for Dallas residents experiencing homelessness, while strengthening the overall effectiveness of the local homeless system.

MISSION

The Bridge is committed to ending homelessness in Dallas by offering compassionate, client-centered care that addresses both immediate needs and the underlying causes of homelessness.



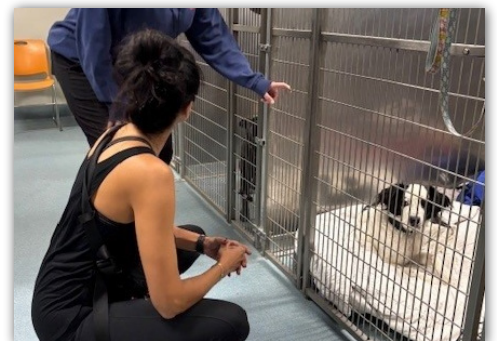
CORE SERVICES

- **Emergency Shelter:** Safe, temporary accommodations for individuals experiencing homelessness.
- **Day Services:** Access to meals, showers, restrooms, and respite, in extreme weather conditions.
- **Case Management:** Individualized support to help clients obtain identification, secure benefits, and develop personalized housing plans.
- **Healthcare Access:** On-site and partner-provided physical and behavioral health services.
- **Employment Assistance:** Job readiness training, resume support, and connections to employment opportunities.
- **Housing Navigation:** Assistance with securing transitional and permanent housing, including rapid rehousing and supportive housing options.



TARGET POPULATION

The Bridge serves single adults experiencing homelessness, including individuals facing chronic homelessness, mental health challenges, and substance use disorders.



FUNDING STREAMS

- **City of Dallas General Fund/State HHSP:** Primary operations funding (approximately \$5.9M).
- **Dallas County Interlocal:** Up to \$1.3M annually to support service operations
- **HUD/TDHCA ESG:** Funding for emergency shelter and rapid rehousing services.
- **Private/Philanthropic:** Supplemental support through grants and contributions



COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The Bridge collaborates with local government agencies, nonprofit organizations, healthcare providers, and community stakeholders to deliver coordinated and effective services across Dallas.



IMPACT

- Provides daily access to essential services for hundreds of individuals
- Supports pathways to permanent housing and stability
- Reduces barriers to employment and healthcare
- Enhances public health and safety in the downtown corridor.

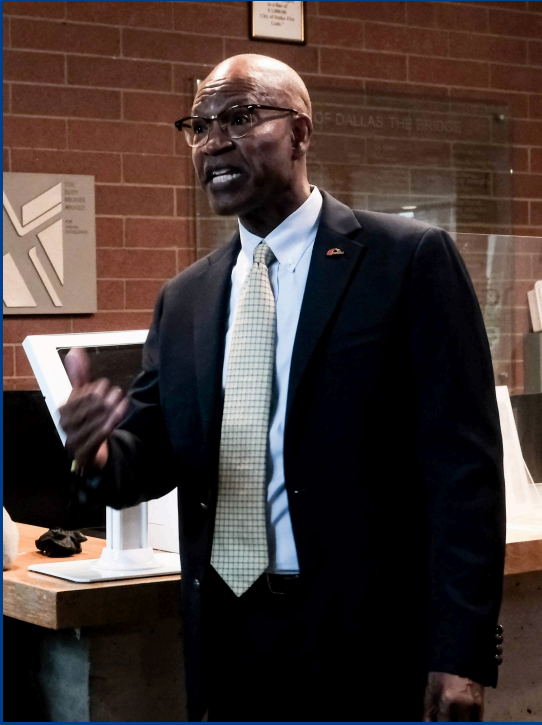


LOCATION & ACCESSIBILITY
