






HOW TO JOIN WEBEX AND SELECT YOUR PREFERRED LANGUAGE (DESKTOP/BROWSER)

- 1) To join the webinar, go to your calendar invite or your registration email and click the WebEx link or "Join Webinar" button. (You can also dial in via phone using the details in the registration email.)



- 2) A new window will open in your browser. You can either join via the WebEx app or click "Cancel" and join via your preferred web browser using the link at the bottom of the page.





4) You will see this screen if the webinar has not started yet:








