3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approve Minutes from the February 1, 2022 Civil Service Regular Board Meeting

Board member Cole moved to accept the minutes as printed. Board member Kutac seconded the motion. The Board unanimously approved the motion.

a. Hear the rehire eligibility appeal of Ms. Loralei Melend, a former employee in Dallas Animal Services.

Appellant did not attend the hearing. Her hearing will be rescheduled to the Board meeting on May 3, 2022.

b. Hear the rehire eligibility appeal of Mr. Collins, a current unclassified employee in Dallas Water Department.

The Board considered information about Mr. Collins' previous employment with the City. After hearing from Mr. Collins, including information about his current City employment and work history with the City, Board member Smotzer made a motion to approve Mr. Collins' appeal to re-apply for classified Civil Service positions. Vice-Chair Marshall-Henson seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved the motion.

5. BRIEFING & DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

a. Departmental Updates and Announcements.

Mr. Davis informed the Board that CVS is preparing for a City-wide hiring event on Thursday, April 7, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the K. Bailey Hutchison Convention Center. CVS will be also participating in Job Fairs at East Field College, Brookhaven College, and Mountain View College on April 12th, 20th and 28th.

Mr. Davis announced that CVS is starting to back up recruitment for Fire operations entry level, and the Candidate Physical Abilities Test training will take place every Monday and Friday in April at the Fire Academy.

He also informed that 222 candidates participated at the Dallas Police Assessment held on March 16th through the 21st; and 504 candidates participated for the Senior Corporal written exam held on March 23rd. CVS has started the Job Analysis for the Fire Battalion Chief exam.

Mr. Davis recognized CVS Employment Analyst, Jennifer Johnson, for her 10-year anniversary with the City.

Vice-Chair Marshall-Henson made the motion to approve the fully successful evaluation rating and \$7,500 increased to Mr. Davis' annual salary. Board member Newman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
