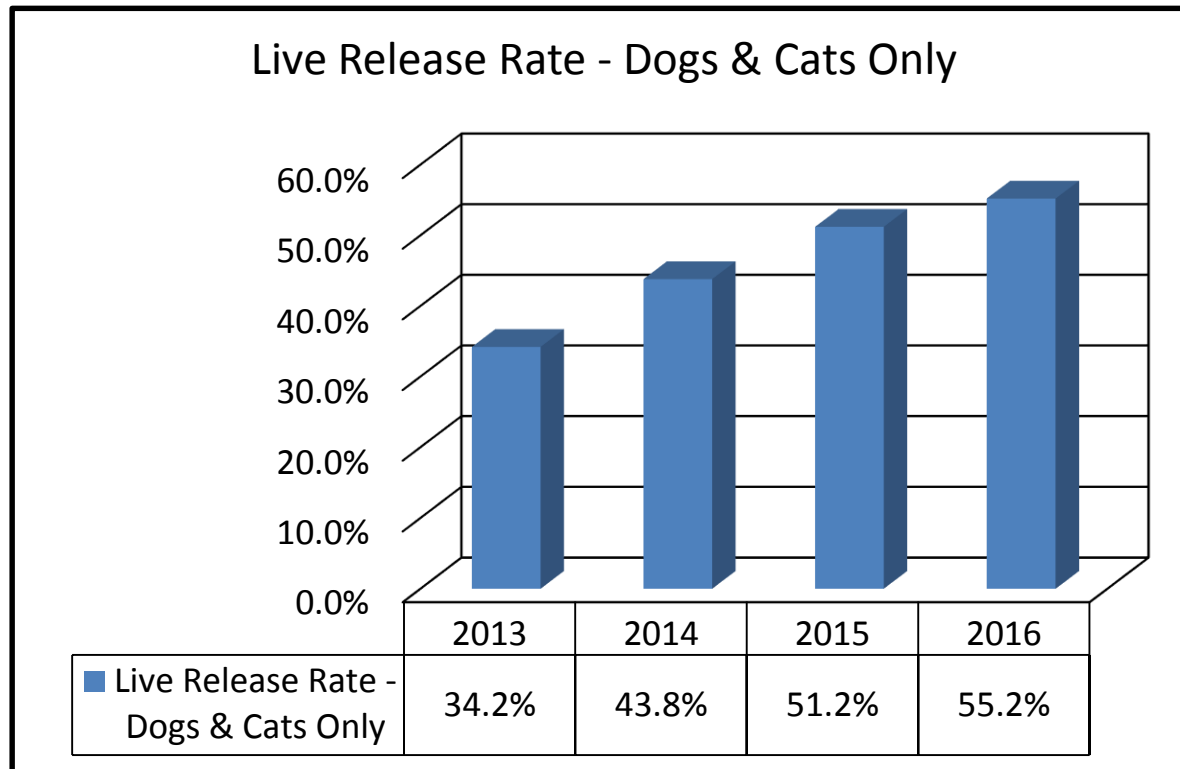

## July 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 Comparison

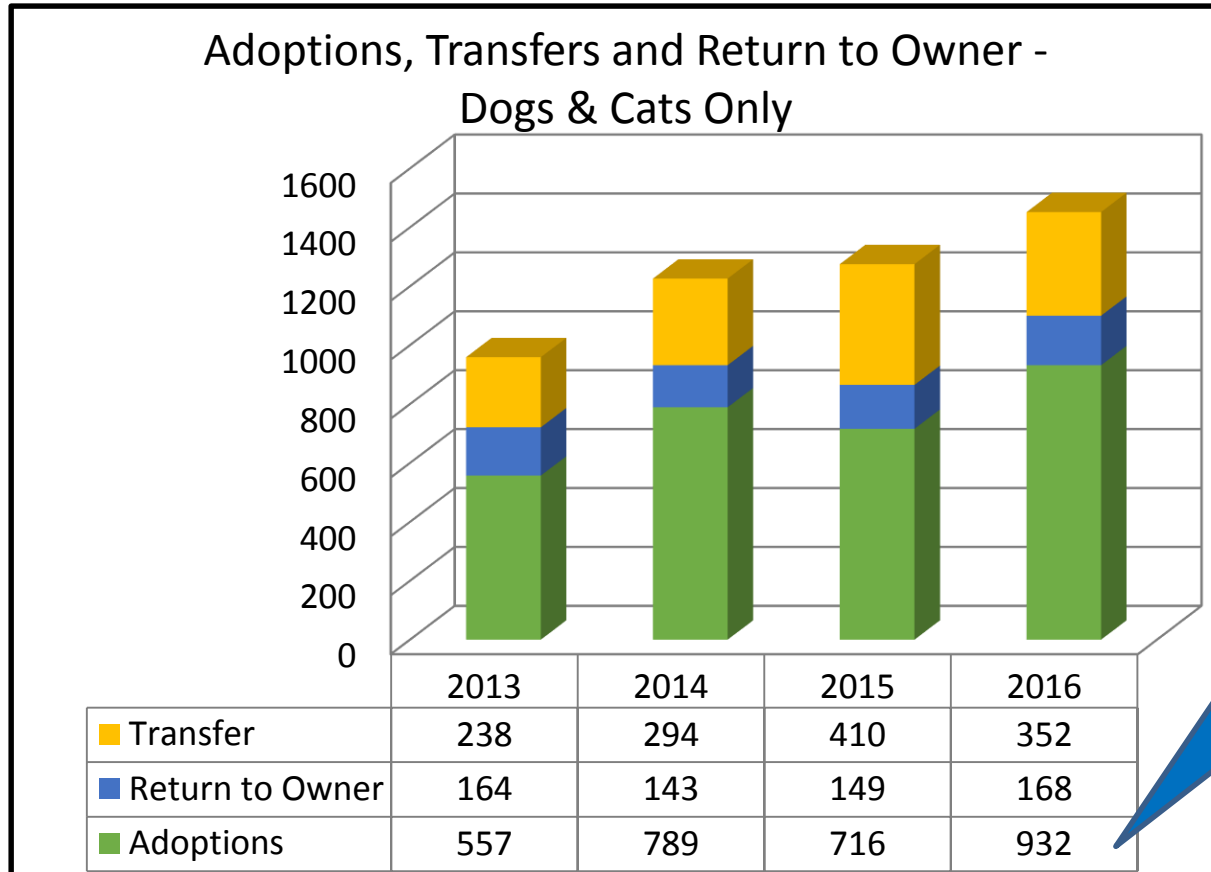


**Live Release Rate for Dogs & Cats is up from 20.3% in July 2011 to 55.2% in July 2016**

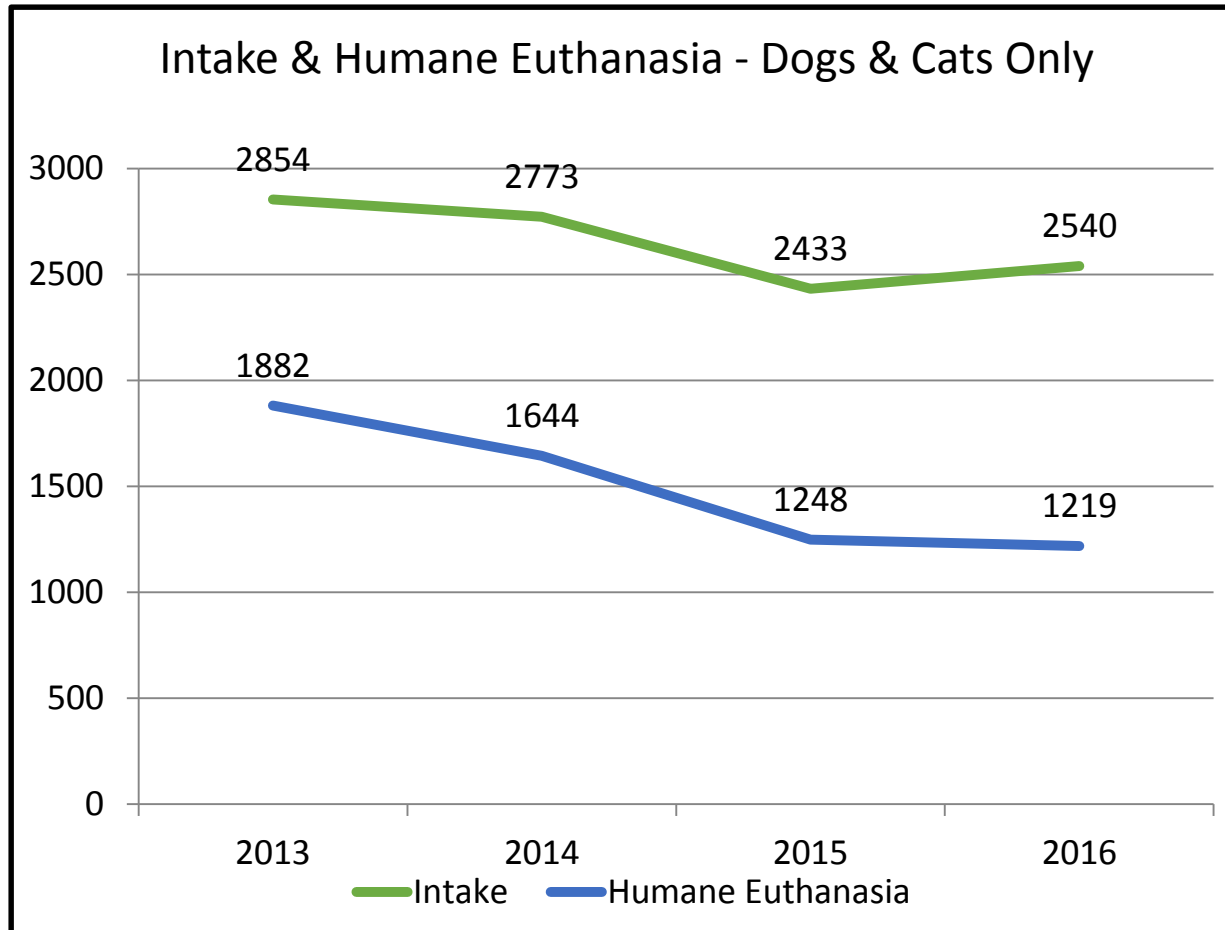

## July 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison

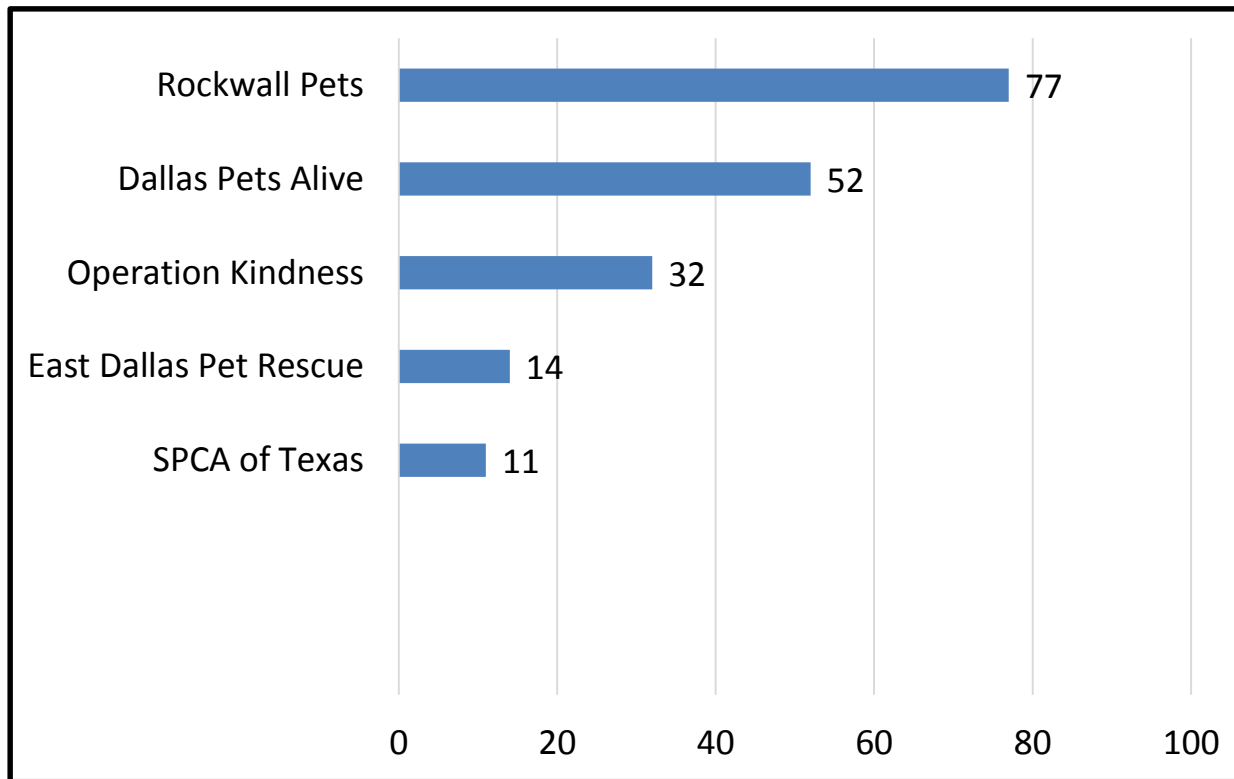


**A new record July low for humane euthanasia of dogs and cats at 1,219, down from 2,056 in July 2011**
