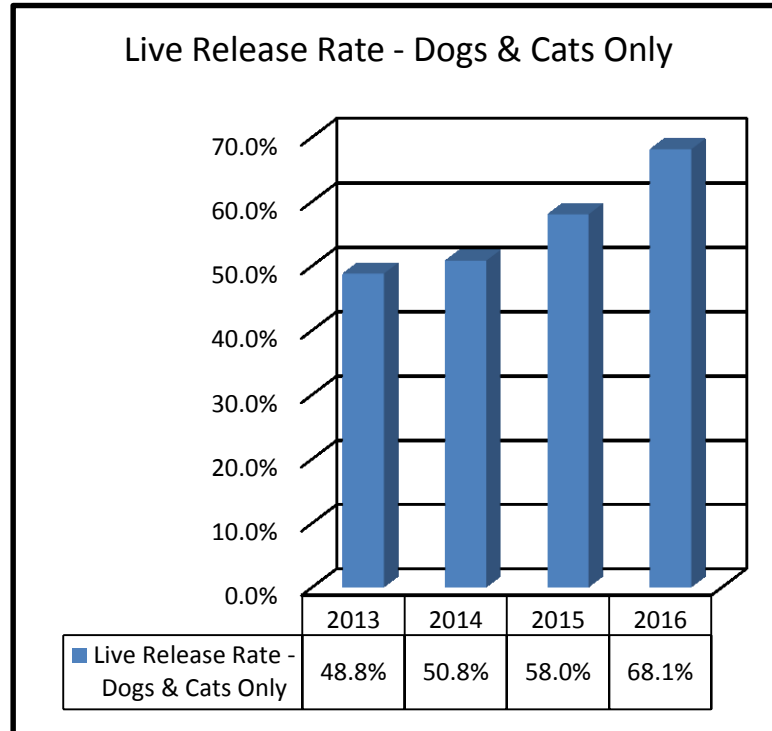

## April 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 Comparison

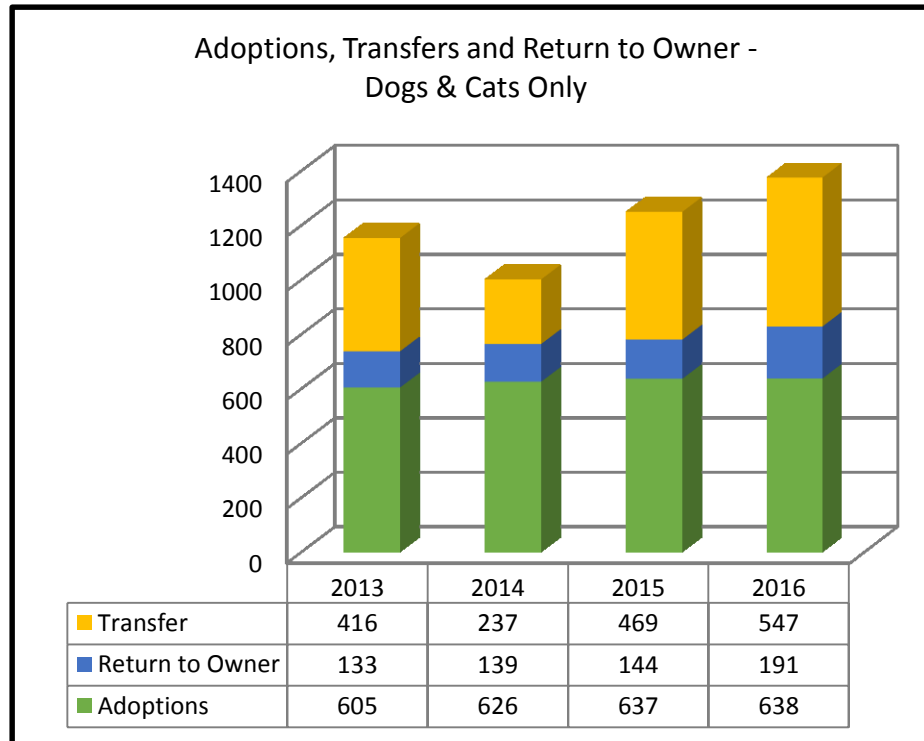


**Live Release Rate for Dogs & Cats is up from 28.7% in April 2011 to 68.1% in April 2016**

## April 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison



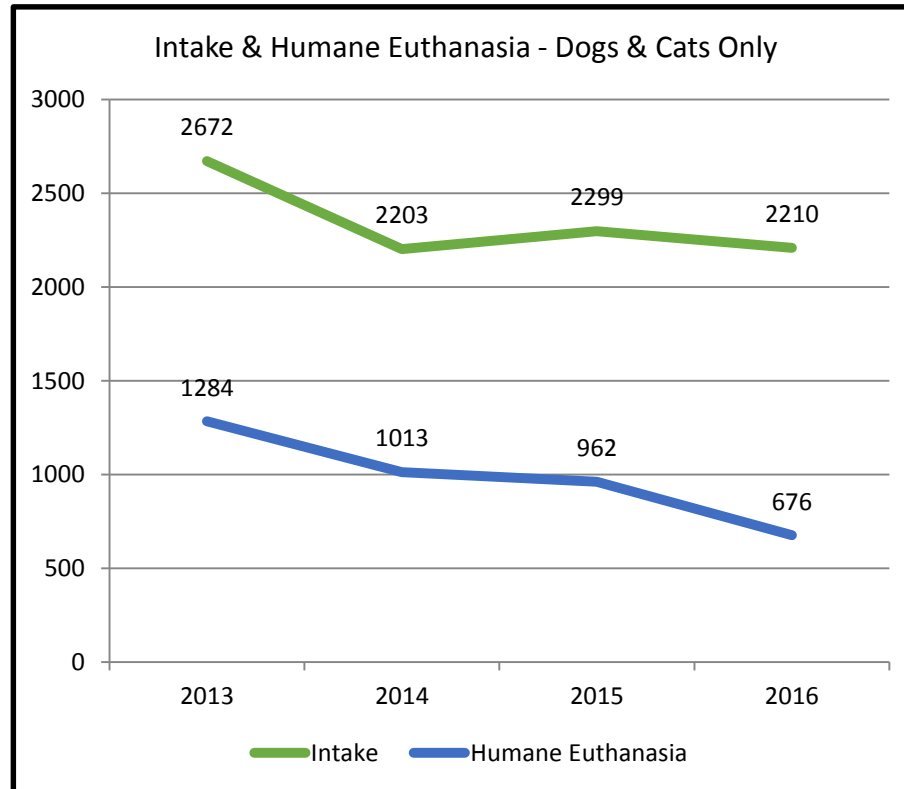

## April 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison

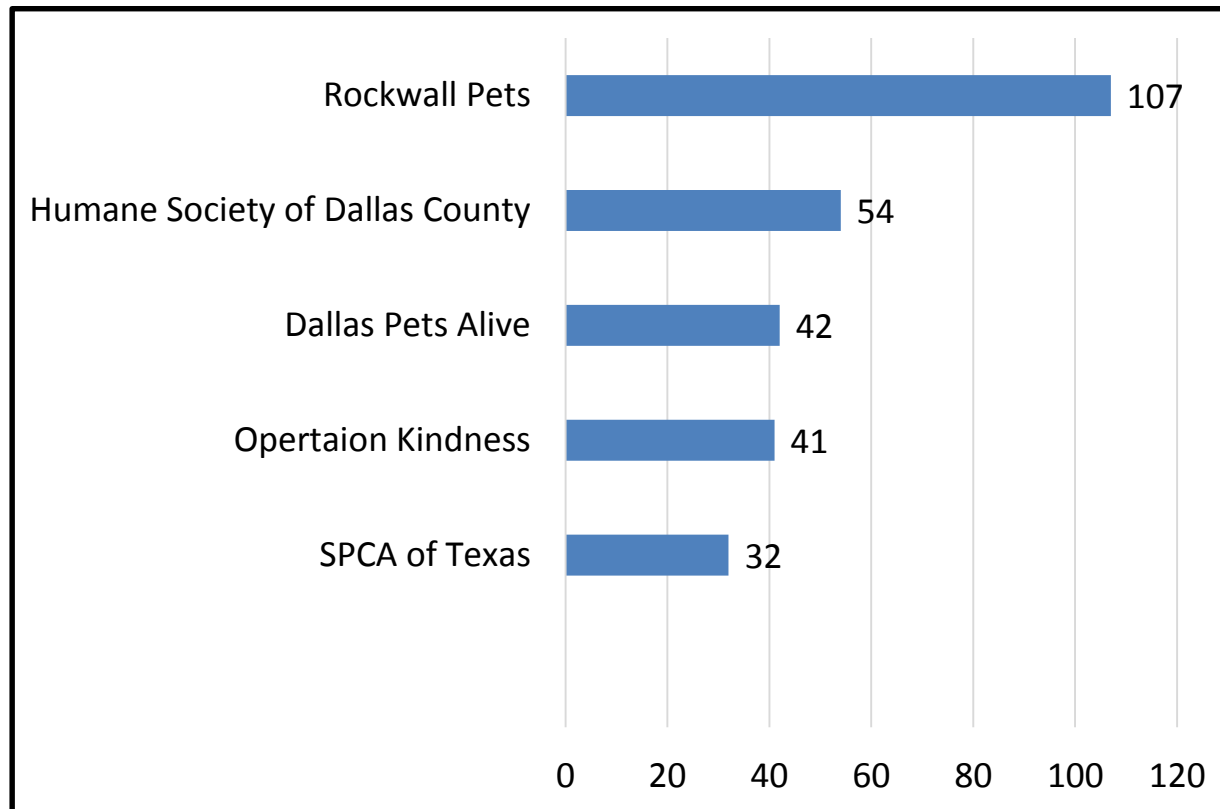


**A new record April low for humane euthanasia of dogs and cats at 676, down from 1,879 in April 2011**

## April 2016 Top Five Transfer Partners

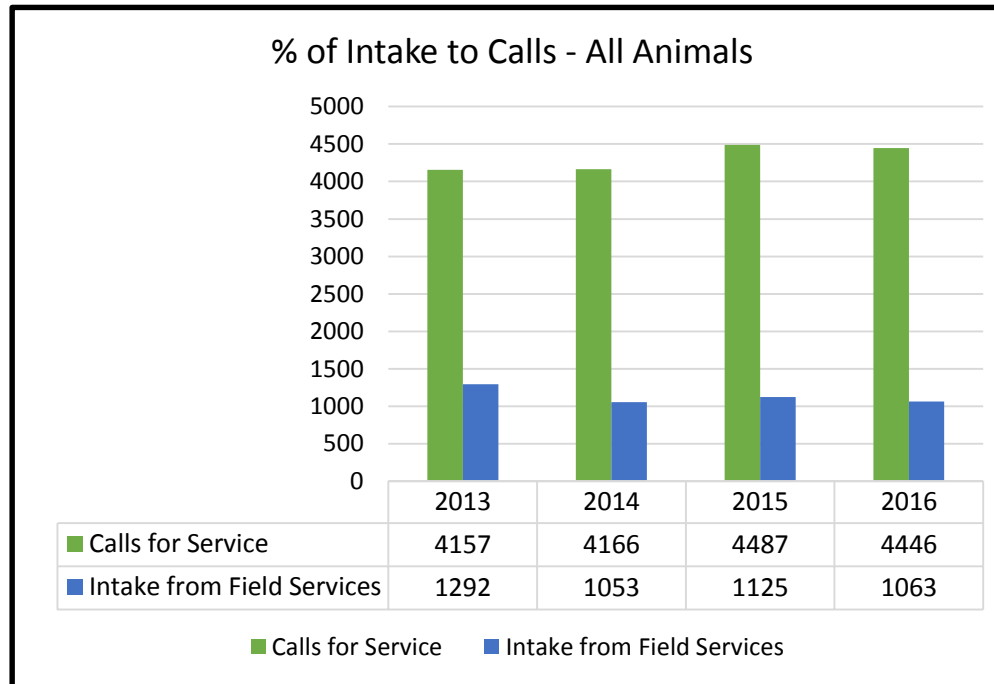
