HELPING IN TIMES OF NEED

As DAS has adjusted to the challenges of a global pandemic, we haven't lost sight of the human-animal bond and have worked to extend our innovative thinking and practices beyond our own community, especially during times of need. Thinking outside of the box, we have proactively provided resources to keep people and pets together in the following ways:

Hurricane Laura Response

In August, DAS worked with Gulf and Dallas-area partners to assist pets and people affected by Hurricane Laura. DAS took in 42 adoptable dogs from coastal shelters in Texas and Louisiana so that they could make room for pets displaced from their owners during the storm. Additionally, DAS worked with the Office of Emergency Management to temporarily house the owned pets of evacuees who were staying in Dallas.



Resources for Pet Owners in Dallas

DAS has also been working to offer more resources designed to keep people and pets together. These include a COVID-19 Resource Guide for those who are struggling to care for their pet due to the pandemic, additional support for those who are missing a pet and a pet support call center in partnership with Spay Neuter Network for residents who may need to rehome their pet. 


YEAR OVER YEAR COMPARISONS*









