## REVIEW CRITERIA

**1. Population Equality:** All districts should have substantially equal population.

- Meets criteria - **deviation exceeds a range of 5%**  
 Does not meet criteria

This plan submission meets the population equality test. All districts have less than a 3% percent deviation from the optimal district size, with an average deviation of **1.18%**. The total range of deviation is **5.58%**.

The deviation range increased from 3.94% to 5.58% between wPlan24a and wPlan24b. The average deviation increased from 1.06% to 1.18% between wPlan24a and wPlan24b.

**2. Minority Representation:** Voting strength of minorities should not be diluted.

- Meets criteria  
 Does not meet criteria

This plan includes 8 minority districts and 2 minority coalition districts. There is no regression noted from the existing 2001 District Plan. **District 3 Total Hispanic Population exceeds 70%, which is considered packing;** however, the Hispanic Voting Age Population is 67.65%.

The original wPlan24 and wPlan24a submission had 8 minority districts and 2 minority coalition districts, with no packing noted.

**3. Contiguity and Compactness:** All districts should be geographically compact and contiguous.

- Meets criteria  
 Does not meet criteria

This plan meets the contiguity and compactness test. All districts are contiguous. On the following page are the compactness scores based on four measures of geographic compactness compared to the City as a whole.

## Other considerations

**1. Incumbents:** The configuration of districts shall be neutral to incumbents.

**2. Communities of Interest:** Where possible, communities of interest shall be maintained in a single district.

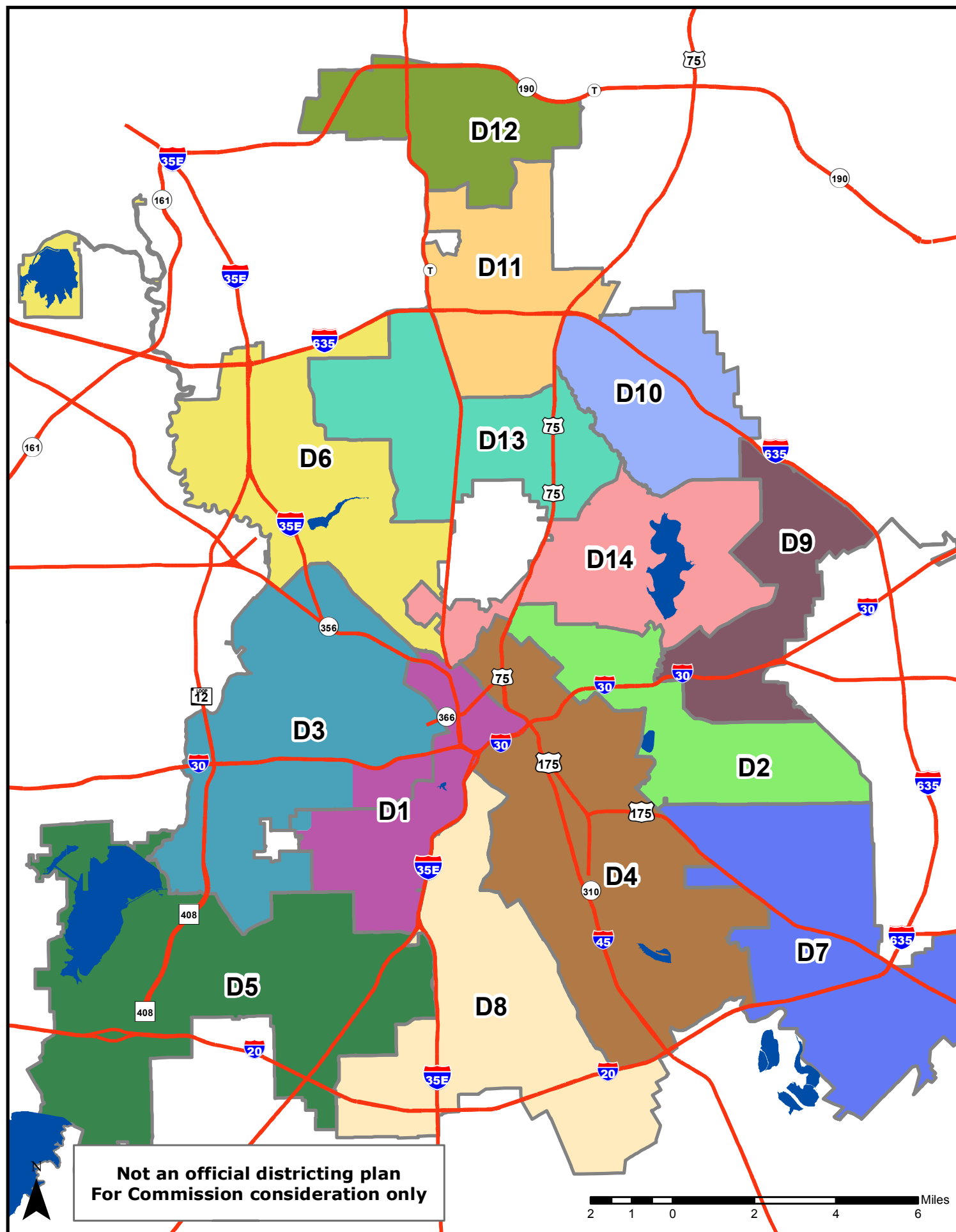
