Position Purpose

Plans, designs, writes, and produces audiovisual material for departmental training/information, and public education.

Essential Functions

- 1. Produces videotape programs to effectively train employees, communicate administrative objectives, and document events or to inform the public.
- 2. Distributes instructional videotapes to support the in-service training programs of emergency operations personnel through cable television and videotape.
- 3. Responds to and videotapes emergency incidents for recording operations on which instructional programs are based.
- 4. Operates and performs minor maintenance on a variety of audiovisual equipment to record, produce and play video programming and other audiovisual materials.
- 5. Maintains the video library for the department; evaluates and acquires programs or services to enhance the audiovisual library and meet specific training objectives.
- 6. Locates and secures location and other production necessities to shoot scene or scenes required.
- 7. Utilizes knowledge and training to determine format and content which will be most effective, meet objectives and remain within budget limits; writes and edits scripts for videos.
- 8. Identifies performance areas that could benefit from utilization of audiovisual training materials and initiates production of appropriate programs to enhance departmental operation.
- 9. Regular, reliable and punctual attendance is an essential function of the job.
