McKinney, Texas

- McKinney is a city in and the <u>county seat</u> of <u>Collin County</u>, <u>Texas</u>, and the second in population to <u>Plano</u>. As of the <u>2010 census</u>, the city's population was 131,117, making it the <u>19th-most populous</u> city in Texas. It is part of the <u>Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex</u>, and is located about 37 miles (60 km) north of <u>Dallas</u>.
- The Census Bureau listed McKinney as the nation's fastest-growing city from 2000 to 2003 and again in 2006, among cities with more than 50,000 people. In 2007, it was ranked second fastest-growing among cities with more than 100,000 people and in 2008 as third fastest. The most recent population estimate, produced by the city as of January 1, 2016, is 161,905.


- Currently the low income housing supply in McKinney is as follows:

 - Senior population 5,946



- 355 Housing Choice Vouchers (use based on budget authority)


MHA Waitlist Public Housing/Housing Choice





Site & Neighborhood Analysis 2015










Affordable Housing Available Units 75069 - May 2016




