



ALL PERMITS ISSUED








983 APPLICATIONS RECEIVED IN 2018/19

109 permit applications were cancelled by the applicant across all permit types.



165 applications were received and not accepted across all permit types. 69 applications were late, 26 did not have any qualifying activities, 13 were declined property authorization.

Only 2 permit applications out of 983 were denied in 2018/19 for failure to meet requirements.

983 total applications were received across all permit types by the Office of Special Events in 2018/19.

707 permits were issued across all permit types. 466 special event permits, 124 commercial film permits, 111 streetlight pole banner permits, and 6 neighborhood market permits.








PERMIT TOTALS - 3 YEARS




Three year summary of all permit types.

Every permit type has experienced a slight decrease of less than 1% except for film which has decreased 30% as several TV shows have left the Dallas market.

The three largest event categories are Festivals, Parties, and Run/walk/ride events.





EVENT METRICS

90 Days

How far in advance of event date are **Applications** received?

On average, applications across all event types are received 90 days in advance of event date. Run/walk/ride events are received 156 days in advance, Parades, Festivals, and Concerts are received 85 days in advance; while Carnivals are only received 57 days in advance.



43 Days

How far in advance from event date are Preliminary Letters sent to clients?

On average, clients across all event types receive their preliminary letter 43 days in advance of their event date. Run/walk/ride events receive their letter 66 days in advance, Festivals receive their letter 42 days in advance, and other event types average 35 days in advance.



11 Days

How far in advance do clients receive **Permits**?


On average, clients across all event types receive their permits 11 days in advance of their event date. Carnivals, Markets, and Parties receive their permit 12 days in advance, Run/walk/ride, Ceremonies, and Festivals, receive their permit 10 days in advance, while Parades receive their permits 7 days in advance.

Dallas' Central Business District which is comprised of Council Districts 2 and 14 received the largest combined event attendance totaling 1.67 million event attendees in the 2018/19 fiscal year. **53%** of all events occur in the








COMMERCIAL FILM PERMITS BY TYPE




The four largest film categories are Commercials, Still Photography, Other/web, and TV Series.





COMMERCIAL FILM METRICS

The Office of Special Events has seen a 30% drop in commercial filming permits since 2017/18.



26 of the 124 (21%) Commercial Film Permits required off-duty police presence.

113 of the 124 (91%) Commercial Film Permits did not require street closures.










Sound Variances
