DISCUSSION

(1) DCA212-005 Consideration of amending the definitions of bedroom, kitchen and bathroom in the Dallas Development Code.

Ms. Levy read the item into the record. Ms. Levy presented on the proposed amendments to the Dallas Development Code Chapter 51 and 51A to revise the definitions for bedroom, kitchen and bath in support of the Comprehensive Environmental Climate Action Plan (CECAP) goals of reducing storm water runoff and reducing the heat island effect. Further, the proposed code amendment directly correlates to the Economic Development Policy (EDP) goals of streamlining the permitting process to approve 90% of building permits within two weeks, and to undergo regulatory review to remove barriers to affordable development.

(1) DCA212-006 Steven Doss Consideration of amending the Dallas Development Code Sections 51A-2.102 Definitions, 51A-4.408 Maximum Building Height, and related sections to modify how building height is measured.

Mr. Doss read the item into the record. Mr. Doss presented on the proposed amendments to the Dallas Development Code Chapter 51A to modify how building height is measured. And how the proposed changes would normalize the city's definition of height, provide additional guidance on where height is measured at the top of a building, and provide additional guidance for allowable rooftop structures, while ensuring that few, if any, existing buildings are put into nonconforming status by the proposed amendments.
