



“COMMUNITY HAND TOOL PROGRAM”

The Code Compliance Department Nuisance Abatement Team is sponsoring a **Community Hand Tool Program** for residential neighborhood groups. This is a city wide initiative serving all areas of Dallas. The primary purpose of the program is to provide neighborhood clean-up volunteers with equipment to mow grass, cut vegetation and clean-up litter in their neighborhood. The community group must be a Church, Neighborhood Association or Non-Profit Organization. The clean-up project may involve mowing a vacant lot or assisting a senior citizen with some property issues. The hand tools will be limited to minor equipment such as hand saws, weed-eaters, hedge clippers, etc. The City will discard collected trash and debris.

All eligible candidates from the community group will participate in a ten (10) minute demonstration/training presentation. The responsible person for the group will sign a waiver of subrogation and acknowledge proper and safe use of equipment. The group must also provide their own Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and other required equipment as needed.

Equipment use will be limited to 10 times per year. The program is limited in the amount of equipment in the inventory so it will be checked out on a first-come first-served basis. The scope of any proposed work may require additional city designations to be included in the participant's work plan.

Record falsification and/or abuse or theft of the equipment will lead to the group being dismissed from the program. The community group's responsible party must insure that all program policies, instructions and requirements are met and maintained.
