City of Dallas Announces 2011 Redistricting Submission to the Department Of Justice

DALLAS – The City of Dallas has submitted its 2011 Adopted City Council Districting Plan Submission to the Department of Justice for preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act. The City of Dallas Council adopted this plan on Wednesday, October 5, 2011.
