## BARRICADE PERMIT APPLICATION CHECKLIST



## APPLICATION CHECKLIST AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

A barricade permit is required for equipment usage, deliveries, on and off loading of materials and storage of materials, supplies, or debris that takes place on public property or within a public way; or, for any temporary or part-day blocking of a street or sidewalk. The holder of a barricade permit is required to repair or replace any public street, curb, sidewalk, drainage structure, or boulevard landscaping located within the barricaded area, or otherwise damaged during construction or demolition, to equal or better condition than that prior to the start of construction or demolition activities. By checking each requirement, you are stating that you have supplied correct and complete information. In the event that the required information is not contained in the submitted documents, you will be notified of the deficiency. Failure to supply the additional requested information within five (5) working days after notification may result in your application being delayed and eventually discarded. A new application, the original application, complete plans and a new checklist will be required for re-submittal for plan review. This re-submittal will be treated as a new application and will be processed in the order of receipt.

□ 1. Proof of commercial general liability insurance and comprehensive automobile liability insurance written by an insurance company approved by the State of Texas and naming city and its officers and employees as additional insured. The contractor must have a Certificate of Insurance on file or provide one with the following coverage and amounts:

a. The policy must provide combined single limits of liability for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$500,000 for each occurrence, or the equivalent, and include coverage for premises operations, independent contractors, products/completed operations, personal injury, contractual liability, and medical payments, and
b. The policy must provide combined single limits of liability for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$500,000 for each occurrence, or the equivalent, for each motor vehicle used by the permit holder.
□ 2. Signed and dated Barricade Permit Indemnification Agreement (attached). The form must be signed by the contractor or the contractor's authorized agent. You must use the City of Dallas form - no other forms are acceptable.
□ 3. Completed Street Closure Form from the City of Dallas Department of Transportation. Call 214-670-6904 for appointment and office location.

## BARRICADE PERMIT INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

APPLICANT agrees to defend, indemnify and hold CITY, its officers, agents and employees, harmless against any and all claims, lawsuits, judgments, costs and expenses for personal injury (including death), property damage or other harm for which recovery of damages is sought that may arise out of or be occasioned by APPLICANT'S breach of any of the terms or provisions of the barricade permit, or by any other negligent of strictly liable act or omission of APPLICANT, its officers, agents, employees or subcontractors in the use of public property as authorized by the permit; except that the indemnity provided for in this paragraph shall apply to any liability resulting from the sole negligence of CITY responsibility (if any) shall be apportioned comparatively in accordance the law of the State of Texas, without waiving any governmental immunity available to the CITY under Texas law. The provisions of this paragraph are solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and not intended to create or grant any rights, contractual or otherwise, to any person or entity.
