Technology Updates



- Online plan review submittals on March 1, 2024.
- DSD is no longer accepting paper plans for building projects (plan review).
- Customers are being directed to ProjectDox portal.
- Improve efficient permit review tracking mechanism.
 - Facilitate accurate Commercial Dashboard data (June launch date)
 - •DSD will continue to partner with homeowners and small business owners to guide them through the online submittal process.
 - Lunch and Learn Sessions (December 2023-March 2024)



Technology Updates




- DallasNow Project is in its 10th month.








Residential Permit Volume








Commerical Remodel Permit Volume








Commerical Permit Volume







Metrics



February 2024

- Residential Permit submittals decreased from 146 to 136.
 - A **7**% decrease from previous month.
 - 191 New Single-Family permits were issued.
 - A total of **50** RSVP permits issued the SAME DAY.
 - The Department issued permits within 4 days for the month.
 - 11 New Commercial, 17 Commercial Additions, 216 Commercial Remodels
 - 32 Complex Commercial Q-Team projects.
 - 24 Minor Commercial Q-Team permits issued SAME DAY.



Q-Team Updates



- Q-Team Project Intake FY 23-24 (October 2023 March 2024)
 - ✓ October 2023: 26 projects
 - ✓ November 2023: 11 projects
 - ✓ December 2023: 12 projects
 - ✓ January 2024: 23 projects
 - ✓ February 2024: 32 projects
- Updated Q-Team & Pre-Development Website Coming May 2024
 - ✓ Website will include:
 - ✓ Updated existing permit applications
 - ✓ New permit applications and checklists specific to Q-Team
- Q-Team Survey Coming May 2024
 - ✓ New survey will be sent to applicants after permit is issued for critical feedback



Minor Q-Team Updates



- In January 2023 Development Services Department (DSD) created the Minor Q-Team
 to compliment and support commercial development that did not meet the current
 qualifying threshold for our standard Q-Team program.
- Qualifying projects will be accepted if they meet the following criteria:
 - ✓ All occupancy uses and classifications
 - ✓ Interior finish outs, renovations, or expansions within existing building footprint
 - ✓ Less than 10,000 square feet total including any expansions
- Q-Team Project Intake FY 23-24 (October 2023 March 2024)
 - ✓ October 2023: 30 projects
 - ✓ November 2023: 53 projects
 - ✓ December 2023: 27 projects
 - ✓ January 2024: 20 projects
 - ✓ February 2024: 24 projects
 - ✓ March 2024: 33 projects



Engineering Q-Team Updates



- Go-Live: March 15, 2024.
- Engineering base fee plus \$1,000 per hour.
- Perform "Same Day" reviews.
- "Conditional" or "Partial" approvals and facilitate "Same Day" permit issuance.

Fire Sprinkler and Fire Alarm Projects Update

The table below shows the number of projects received from Oct 1st, 2023 to April 1st, 2024

Project Type	# of Submittals	Completed	Av. Turnaround time	% of in-house reviews*
Fire Sprinklers	568 (+234)	519 (+209)	9 days (+0)	73% (+11)
Fire Alarm	1114 (+399)	1046 (+356)	6 days (1)	100%

^{*} In-house reviews are submittals reviewed by the City Staff.

Transition to 100% Online Submittals/Services

- Fire Protection team is accepting PDOX projects only for Standalone Permits staring
 April 1st, 2024. We continue to accept paper submittals for validations.
- Fire Contractor Registrations are available now on Teams starting April 1st, 2024.
- ERRCs Fire Contractors are being registered with their FCC number.



FASST Update



- Fire Sprinkler & Alarm Same-Day Team (FASST) is an expedited review service to provide same day initial review.
- FASST is in effect starting April 1st, 2024 for qualified projects.
- Offered on an appointment basis only.
- Bookings made on an Online Webpage and more than one project can be submitted on the day of the review.
- \$200 per hour, with a non-refundable min charge of \$500.


