

# GENERAL REPAIR SCOPE OF WORK ATTACHMENT TO BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION



Inclusive in the scope of work described below, the scope of work **DOES NOT** include any of the following:

1. The removal of any wall, partition, or the removal of any part of a wall or partition;
2. The permanent, partial or complete removal of any structural component; or the change, strengthening, bracing, or addition of load bearing floor, wall, ceiling and/or roof elements;
3. The removal or rearrangement of any part of a required means of egress; and/or
4. Addition to, alteration or relocation of:
  - a. any fire protection system (fire alarm/sprinkler system) or portion thereof;
  - b. water supply, sewer, drainage, gas, oil, waste, vent, or similar piping (plumbing work);
  - c. electrical wiring, other than wiring for a low voltage communication system in a one- or two-family dwelling;
  - d. mechanical system components such as ductwork; or
  - e. elevator devices.

**Scope of general repair work proposed:**
