Shahla,

As discussed this morning, and as requested, we are emailing our comments.

With the aviation industry's change regarding the requirement for foam fire suppression systems, as adopted in the 2022 edition of NFPA 409, we would like to request that the City also adopt this new version of NFPA 409 in the Dallas Building Code. This revision now allows hangars to be built with *either* a foam suppression or sprinkler system due to the extent of property damage caused by the foam suppression systems around the country.
