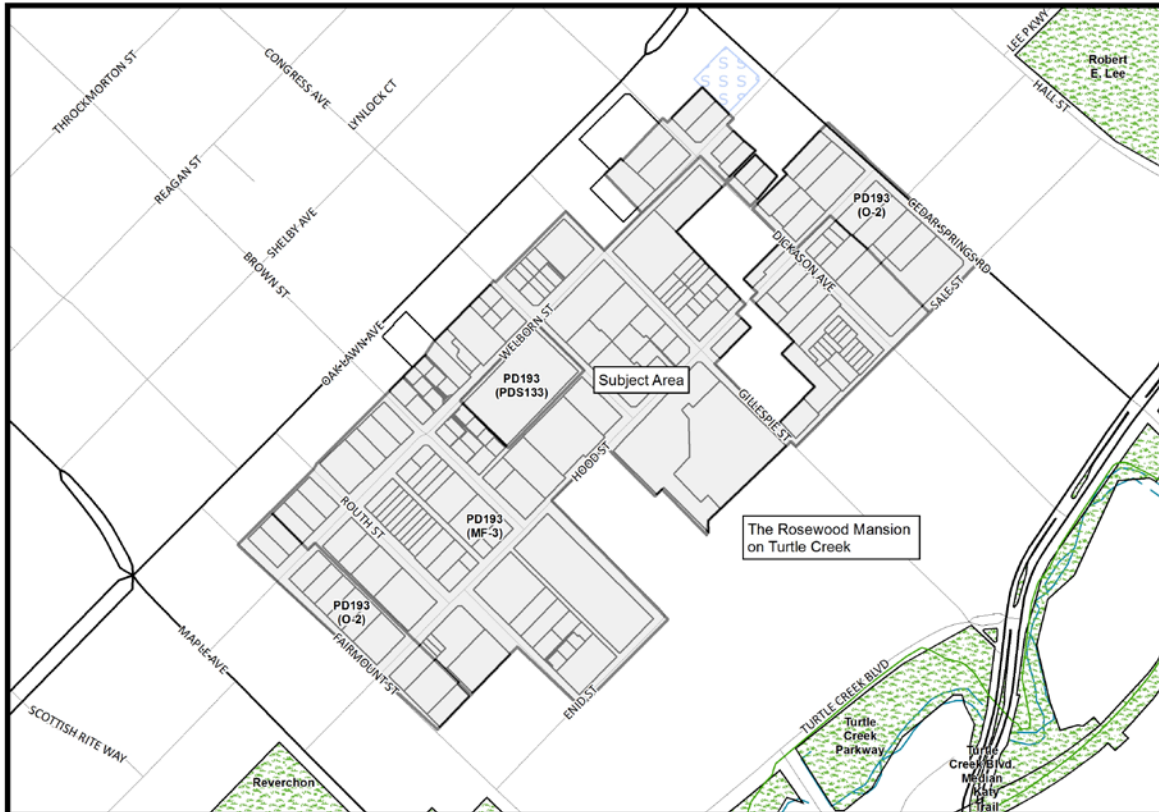


City Council Member Philip Kingston

This area is currently zoned an MF-3 Multifamily Subdistrict, an O-2 Office Subdistrict, and Planned Development Subdistrict No. 133 within Planned Development District No. 193, the Oak Lawn Special Purpose District.

Council Member Kingston would like to know what, if any, changes should be made to the existing zoning regulations for this area. Please attend the meeting and be heard, as you may be affected by future amendments.
