Thoroughfare Plan

The Thoroughfare Plan (Ordinance #20860) is a comprehensive plan that establishes terminology, standards and general principles and guides decision making for all aspects of roadway planning. The plan sets the minimum standards for roadway and provides for the classification of various roadways. It identifies the functional (grouped according to intended service) and dimensional (physical dimensions) characteristics of roadways. The Thoroughfare Plan includes a map that delineates thoroughfare routes, classifications, and street segments. The Thoroughfare Plan also allows for a process to amend the plan when a need to amend is determined. Local streets are not listed in the City of Dallas' Thoroughfare Plan.

Central Business District Streets and Vehicular Circulation Plan

The Dallas Central Business District Streets and Vehicular Circulation Plan (CBD Plan) (Ordinance #13262) is a plan providing for a more efficient and functional CBD street system, which proposes detailed street improvements and adjustments, a vehicular circulation plan, and a streets and freeway plan. The CBD Plan classifies future street adjustments, prescribes standards and adjusts alignments and widths of various streets, identifies streets which may be closed, defines new streets, and creates a vehicular circulation system. The CBD Plan also allows for a process to amend the plan when a need to amend is determined.
