

Masters Drive and St. Augustine Road Transportation Safety Study

Limits: US 175 to Military Parkway

BACKGROUND

The City of Dallas has committed to eliminating traffic-related deaths and reducing severe-injury crashes by 50% by 2030. These corridors have been prioritized because they are part of the city's High Injury Network – the 7% of Dallas roads that account for 62% of the city's fatal and severe-injury crashes. Additionally, the corridors overlap with equity focus areas.

STUDY DESCRIPTION

The Masters Drive and St. Augustine Road Transportation Safety Study aims to assess existing transportation conditions, evaluate multimodal mobility and crash history, and recommend improvements that will reduce severe traffic crashes and improve the quality of life for all roadway users. The study also aims to identify which corridor would be better for a bike lane.
