Directions from City Hall to Bachman Water Treatment Plant

- From City Hall travel west on S. Akard Street
- Turn right onto Canton Street
- Turn left onto the I-35E ramp
- Keep left at the fork and continue toward I-35E
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for I-35E N/Denton N
- Keep left, follow signs for Fort Worth W
- Continue onto Exit 45A
- Merge onto I-35E
- Keep right at the fork to continue on I-35E N, follow signs for I-35E N/Denton
- Take exit 435 for Harry Hines Blvd
- Turn right on Harry Hines Blvd
- Turn left onto Shorecrest Drive
- The plant will be on your left. Continue west on Shorecrest to the main entry located near the Dallas Rowing Club.
