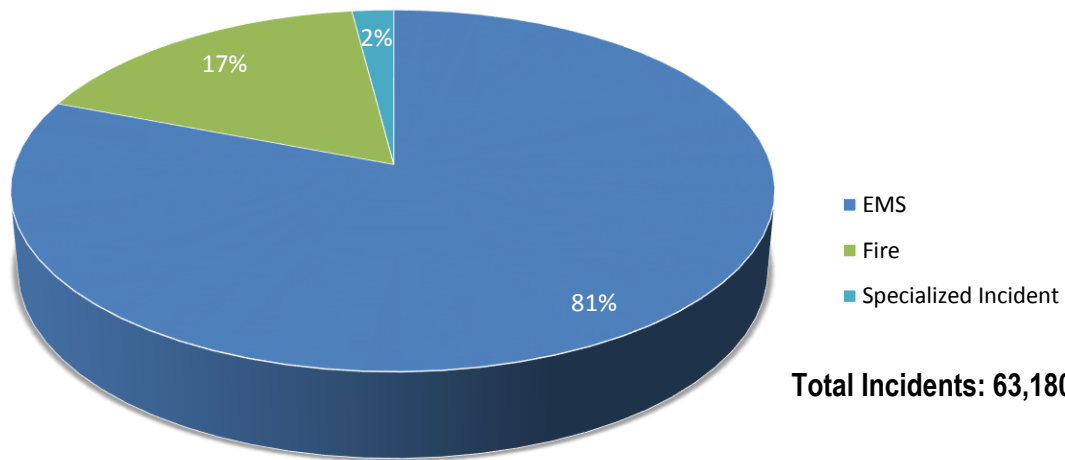

Narrative	<p>This is an undetermined fire that originated in unit #302. Upon arrival, firefighters saw smoke and fire coming from the third story window. The fire spread along the walls to units #301 and #303 before traveling vertically into the attic space. The fire resulted in major fire damage to the structure and contents. Truck 37 was the first arriving company.</p>
