



## Coombs Creek Trail Improvements Project

Limits: 800 Block of N. Plymouth Rd. from Bahama Dr. to the 2600 Block of Sunset Ave. at Moss Park.

## Scope of Work

- 2300 LF 10ft. wide reinforced concrete trail
- 1130 LF 8ft. wide






- Existing sidewalk on west side of Plymouth Rd. to be replaced with 10ft, wide trail.
- Insufficient street right-of-way width at two locations requiring a reduced 8ft. wide trail.
  - Holiday Hills Apartments Parking
     Lot
  - Crossing Plymouth Rd. vehicular Bridge
- Add Alternate No. 1-Improvements: Conduit and bases for future light poles along trail.










- Existing sidewalk on west side of Plymouth Rd. to be widened to 10ft. wide trail.
  - Curb and Gutter on the west side of the street to be moved out into the street to accommodate wider sidewalk/trail width.
  - Revise existing median striping to maintain 12ft. vehicular lane width.











• Trail will be within the grass median after crossing Jefferson Blvd.



















- Trail Head constructed at Moss Park

EXAMPLE OF SALT FINISH CONCRETE W/ SAWCUT GRID



## Grant Application

 Park and Recreation Department submitted the project in an application for the 2020 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects through NCTCOG. If selected the City will receive Federal Grant Funds equaling \$1.5 Million from the Federal Highway Administration. The grant program will be administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT)
