Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Initiative

- MOU with DART for City team (ECO and PUD) to market (6) DART-owned sites, adjacent to light rail stations, for real estate redevelopment; stations include:
 - 8th and Corinth Station
 - Hampton Station
 - Westmoreland Station
 - Lake June Station
 - Buckner Station
 - Royal Lane Station





Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Initiative (Continued)

- City issued (6) RFPs (one for each station) in September 2022
- The solicitation period closed in December 2022
- A total of (12) proposals were received
- Evaluation panel (composed of City and DART staff) has reviewed the proposals and interviews are scheduled for March 2023
- Next steps to be briefed to the Economic
 Development Committee in the coming months
