## Recruit and Officer Training Journey



### **DPD Training – State Requirements**

State/TCOLE requires separation of Basic Peace Officer Course (BPOC) and post BPOC within classrooms.

### **Basic:**


BPOC training – 60%

Post BPOC – 40%

#### **In-Service**

Post BPOC – 100% of training

The separation of recruits and officers aligns with standard best practices, current police academy facility layout, and operational procedures.











## **DPD** and UNTD Collaboration



<u>Collaboration Objective</u>: To enhance police training through academic and practical approaches.

<u>Partnership with a Tier One University</u>: UNTD's criminal justice faculty will collaborate with the Dallas Police Department to provide high-quality, comprehensive law enforcement training, including three core classes to new recruits.

<u>Curriculum</u>: The partnership between DPD and UNTD will focus on critical areas promoting 21st century policing strategies.

**Real-World Impact**: Ensures a well-educated police workforce where officers are positioned to effectively address the challenges of contemporary policing.







## DPD and UNTD Collaboration



<u>Improved Policing Techniques</u>: New recruits and officers gain access to cutting-edge research and best practices.

<u>Community Relations</u>: Engaging with UNTD students, facility and various community groups will enhance relationships between law enforcement and the community.

<u>Professional Development</u>: New recruits and officers receive continuous education and may earn college credit to support their career advancement through UNTD's degree pathways.

<u>Outcomes</u>: Law enforcement pipeline with job opportunities for UNT students including sworn and non-sworn positions and a more efficient, ethical, and community-focused police force prepared for the challenges of modern-day law enforcement.
