# Community Development Block Grant Funds – FY 2025-26 Spend Plan for the period ending October 31, 2025

To ensure that CDBG funds are spent in a timely manner, HUD rules require that the City's CDBG line of credit does not exceed 1.5 times our latest CDBG allocation. This requirement is tested annually on August 2. On August 2, 2025, the city did not meet the CDBG timeliness tests. This is the second consecutive year the city did not meet timely expenditure standards for the CDBG program. There are two tests, one is based on CDBG grant funds only and the second test is based on CDBG grant funds plus program income. For both tests, the City's ratio was greater than the minimum balance threshold. On September 4, 2025, HUD officially notified the city that the CDBG program is not being carried out in a timely manner. Since this is the second year, additional corrective actions are required. The city developed a workout plan describing steps to ensure the CDBG line of credit remains at or below 1.5 by August 2, 2026. These steps include monthly progress briefings to the Community Development Commission (CDC) and providing a monthly financial status report to the Finance Committee.

Please find the financial status report for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FY 2025-26 Spend Plan for the period ending October 31, 2025. This monthly report provides an overview of the City's progress toward meeting the CDBG timely expenditure requirements by August 2, 2026.

#### How to Read the Financial Status Report

The report includes the FY 2025-26 CDBG Allocation (Column A) which reflects the FY 2025-26 allocation from HUD, plus one-time revenue and projected program income during the fiscal year; Balance as of 08/02/2025 (Column B) which reflects the funding available from prior year unspent funds used in the timeliness test calculation; the Projected Goal (Drawdown by July 2026) (Column C) which reflects the amount the City of Dallas forecast to spend by July 31, 2026 in order to meet or exceed the CDBG timeliness tests; and the YTD Actuals (Column D) which reflects actual expenses spent and drawn from HUD through the end of the most recent accounting period. The YTD actuals will be updated each month and compared to the Projected Goal (Drawdown

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> by July 2026). The Notes (Column E) will include comments regarding the status of the project and potential impacts to the Projected Goal (Drawdown by July 2026).

- **C** = The Projected Goal (Drawdown by July 31, 2026) reflects the amount the City forecast to spend by July 1, 2026 to meet or exceed the CDBG timeliness test.
- **D** = YTD (fiscal year) expenditures spent and drawn from HUD. Encumbered funds do not count toward timely expenditure threshold. This number will be updated each month.
