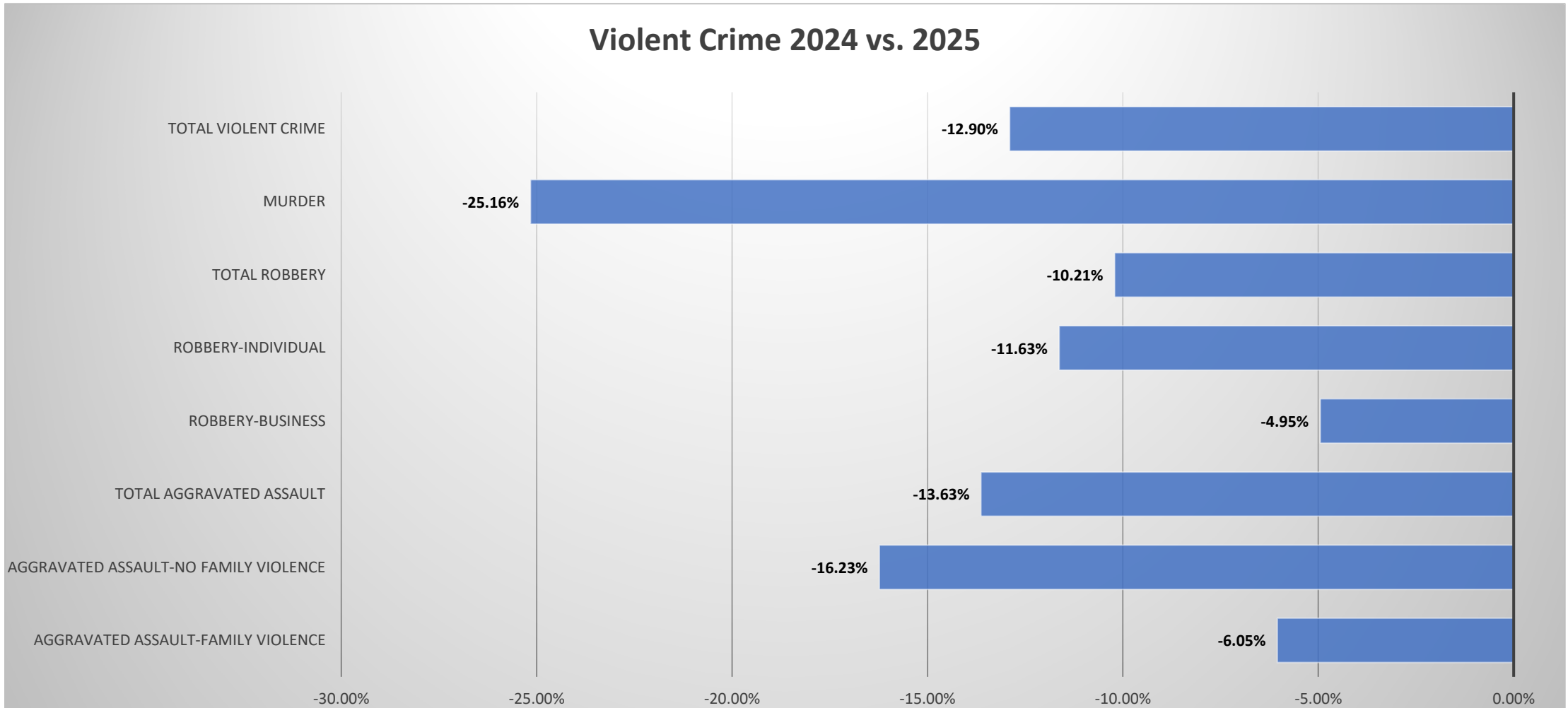
SUMMARY OF OCTOBER



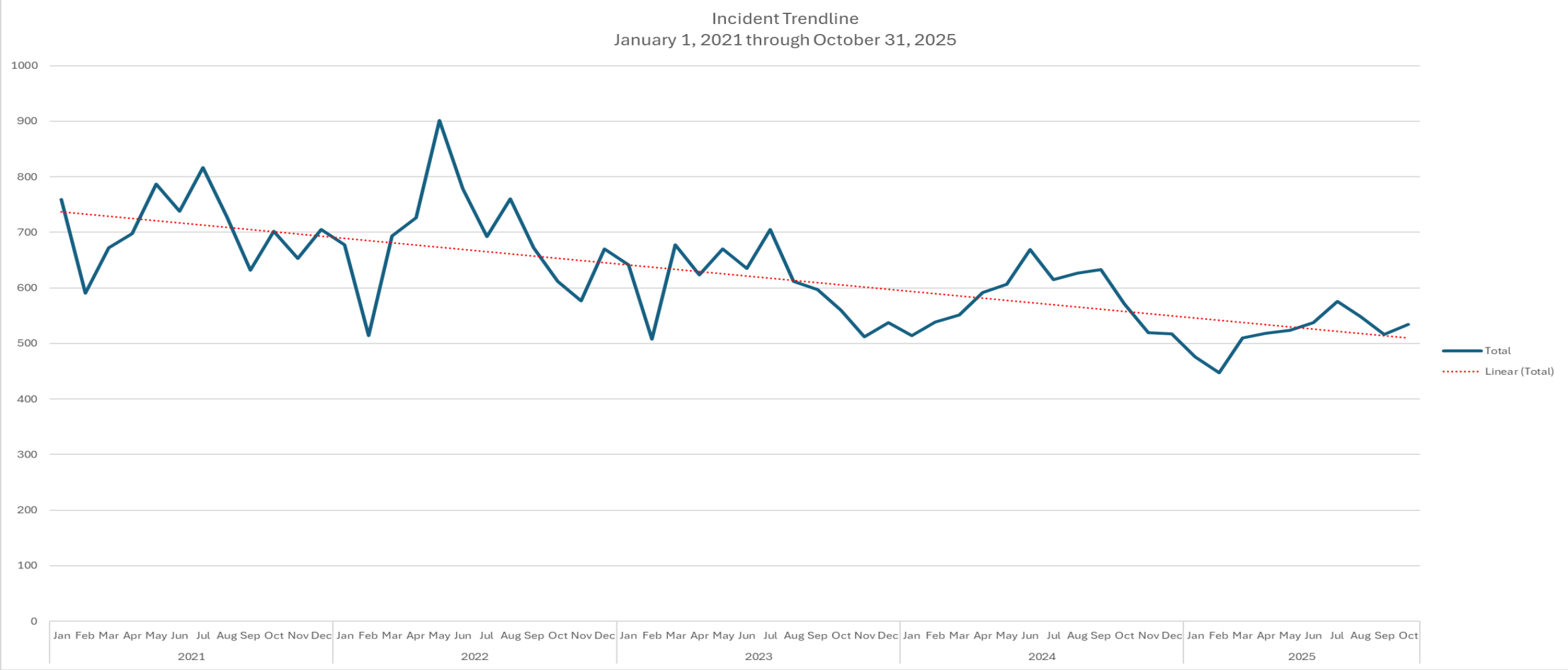
- Overall Violent Crime is down by **–12.90%**
- There are three significant contributing factors as of year-to-date:
 - Aggravated Assaults have decreased **–13.63%**
 - Homicides have decreased **–25.16%**
 - Domestic Violence Month Operation **539 arrest**



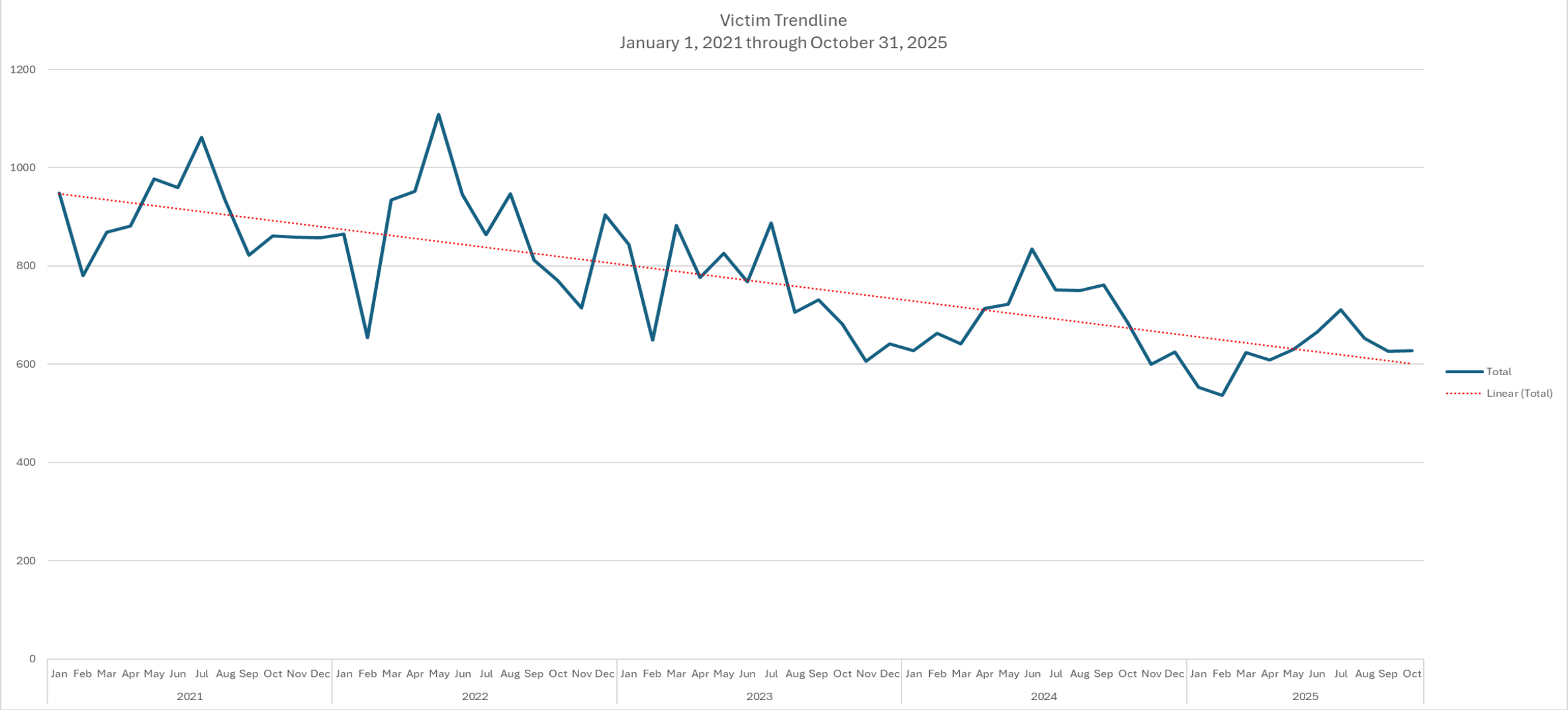

- 2025 Murder Trend
- As of October 31st, Murders **-26.11%**
- The Murders involving FV increased by 1 YTD

- 2025 Robbery Trend
- Robberies **-10.21%** (193 Fewer Victims)
- Business Robberies **-4.95%** (20 Fewer Victims)
- Individual Robberies **-11.63%** (173 Fewer Victims)

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT



- 2025 Aggravated Assault Trend
- Aggravated Assaults **-13.36%** (682 Fewer Victims)
- Aggravated Assaults FV **-6.05%** (87 Fewer Victims)
- Aggravated Assaults NFV **-16.23%** (595 Fewer Victims)

VCPU FOCUSED DETERRENCE



- Focused Deterrence has 77 current clients.
