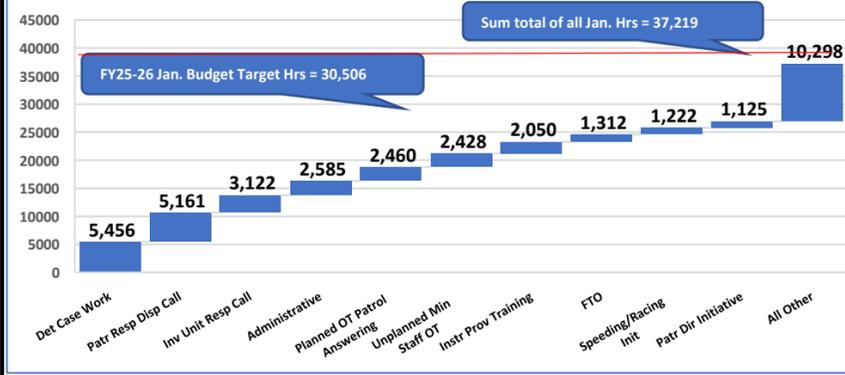

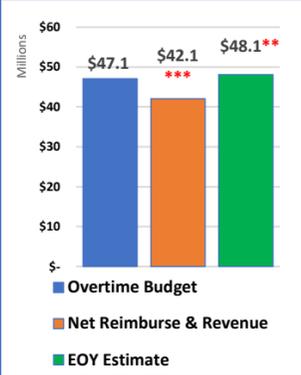

Jan Top 10 OT Activity Codes (By Hrs.)*



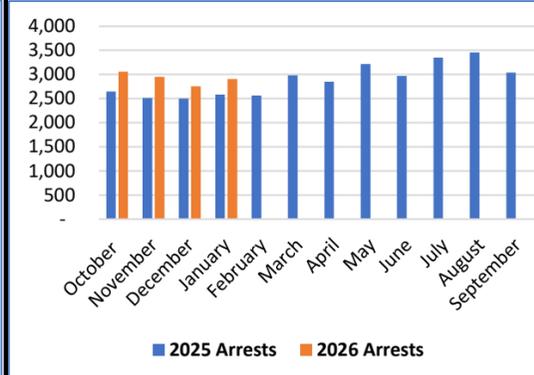

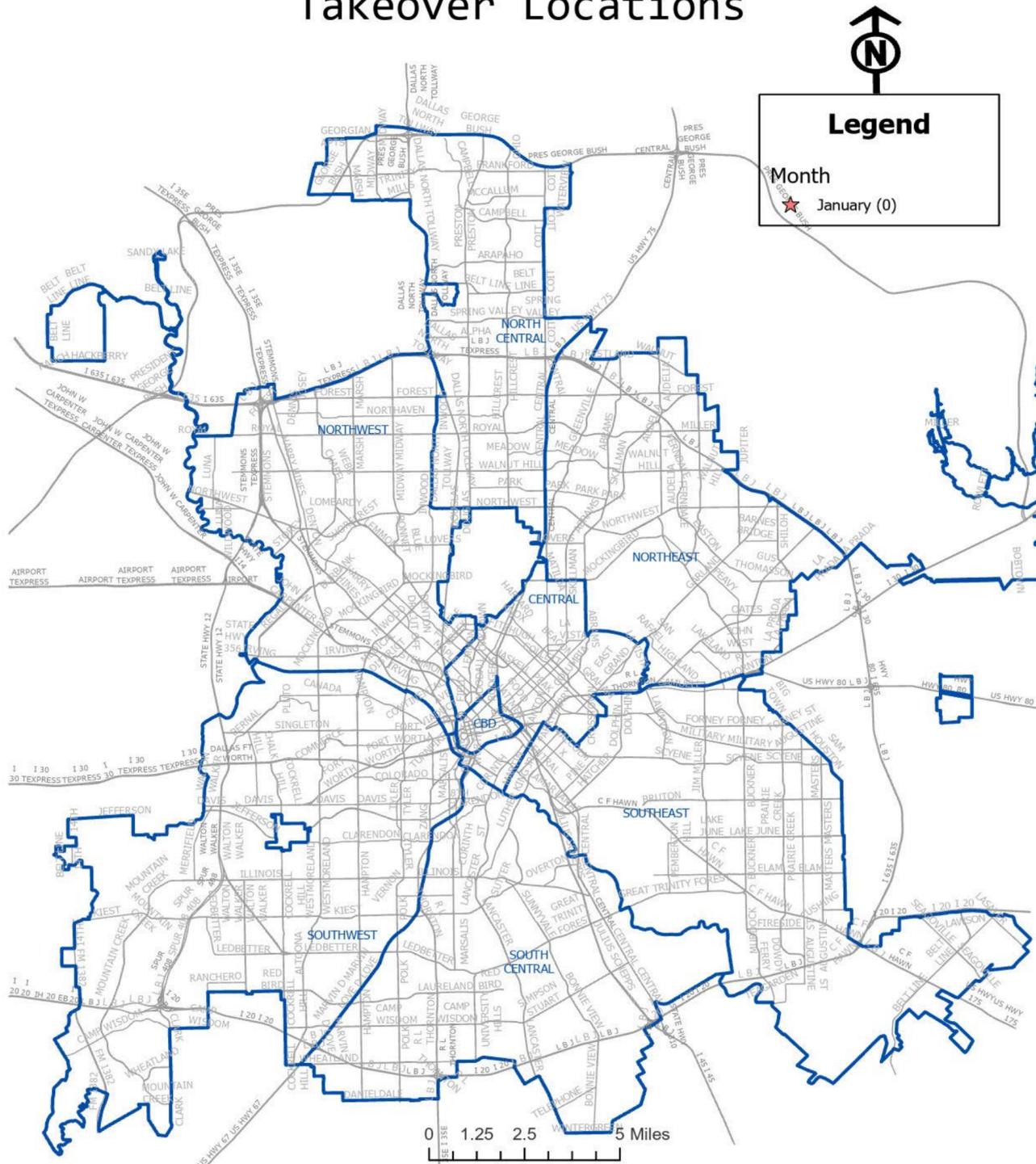

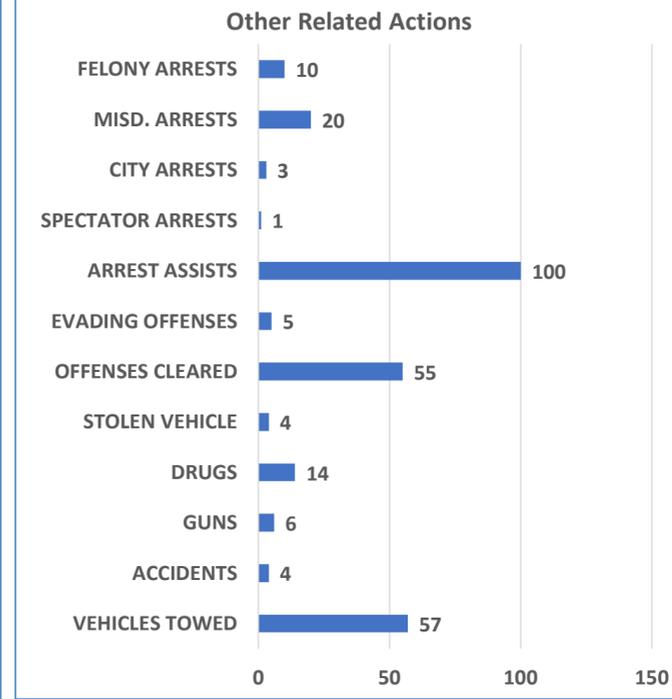
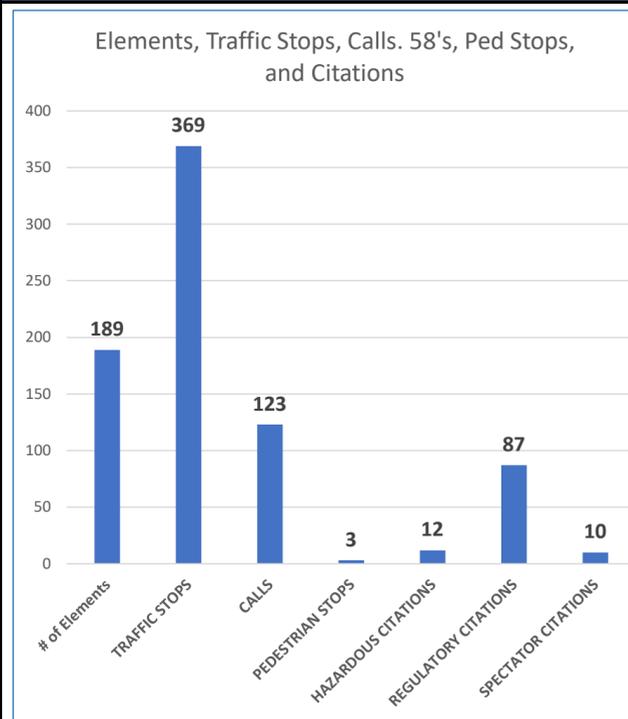
Takeover Locations



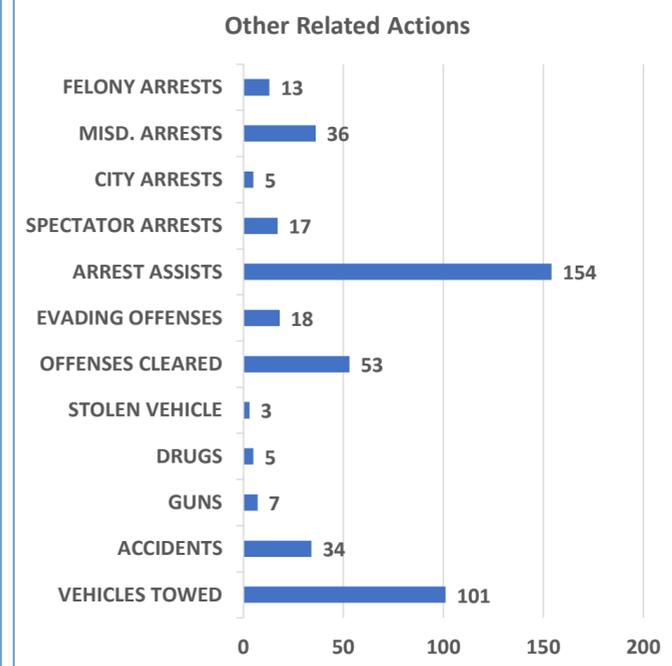
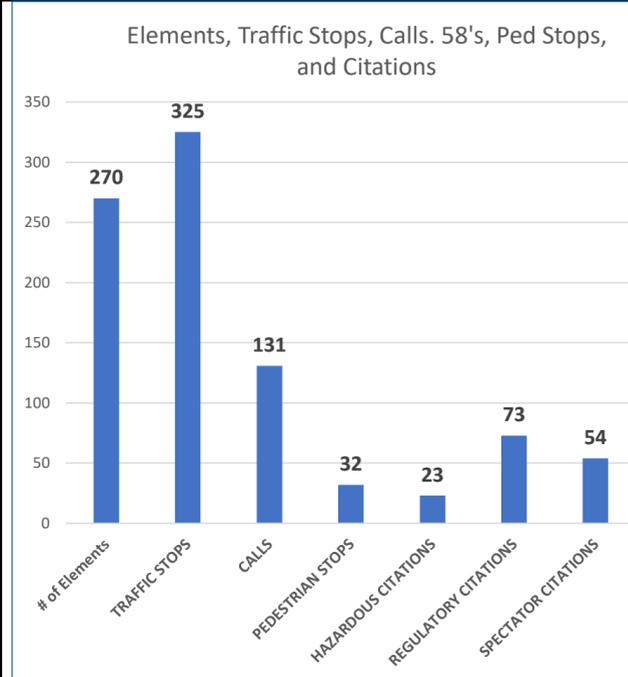

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SUBJECT **Dallas Fire-Rescue's Public Safety Dashboard - January 2026**

Dallas Fire-Rescue (DFR) had 24,721 dispatched incidents for January, an increase from the 23,336 in December. As you are aware, DFR has a stated goal of achieving 90% of the metrics for EMS response within 9 minutes and Structure Fire Response within 5 minutes and 20 seconds. DFR did not reach these goals for EMS (84%) and Fire response (87%) but the department continues to explore response time efficiencies to meet these standards.

DFR had six (6) significant fires in January, down from eight (8) in December. Inspection activity increased from December (2,664) to (3,782) in during this reporting month. Our rescue unit hours of utilization (UHU) numbers increased to 34.8% for Frontline units.

We currently have 105 recruits at various stages of training, scheduled to be assigned to the field between April 2026 and February 2027. For your quick reference, you can access DFR's Dashboard using the following link:

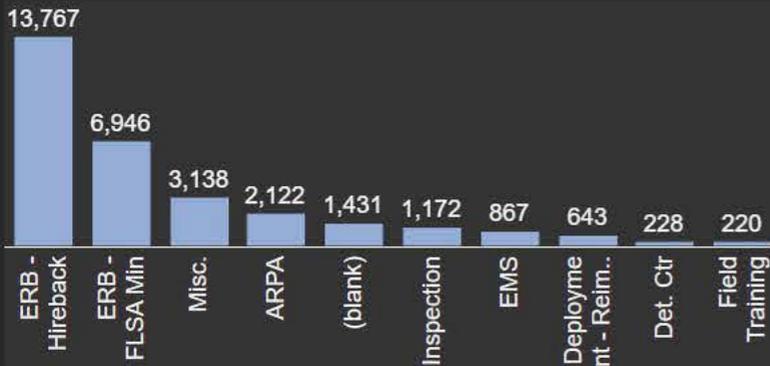

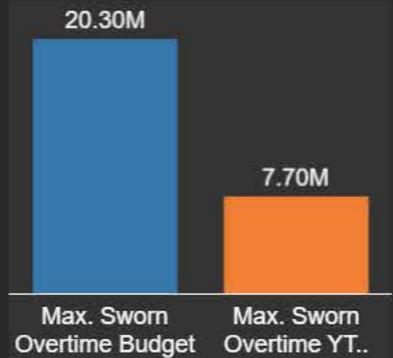

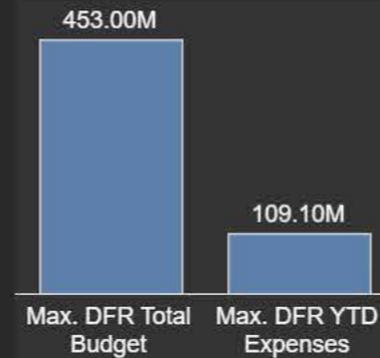
Overtime Hours Breakdown Categorías de Horas Extras Trabajadas



Sworn Overtime Propuesto de Horas Extras



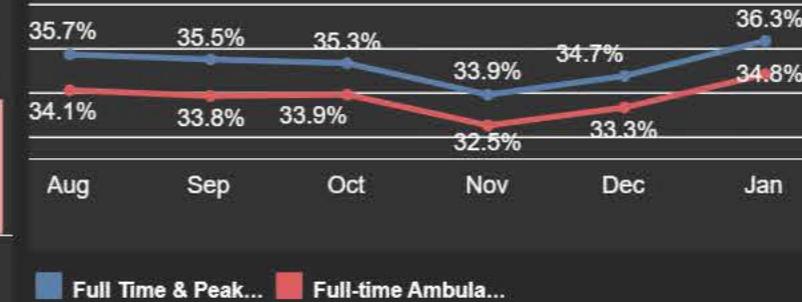

Ambulance Unit Hour Utilization Rate Tasa de Utilización de Ambulancias (Optimal 25-30%)

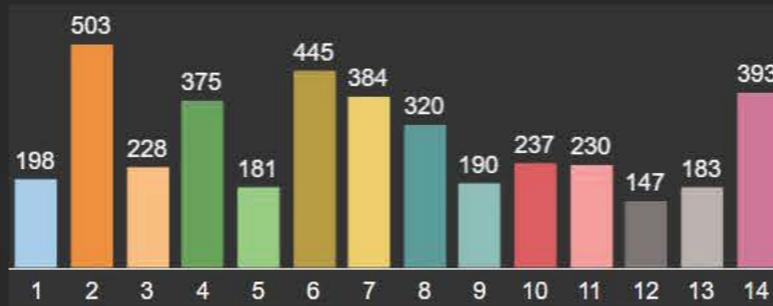

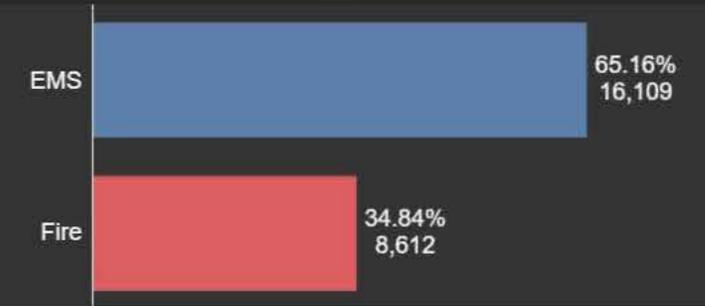
Incident Response Data by Council District Incidentes por Distrito del Concejo Municipal



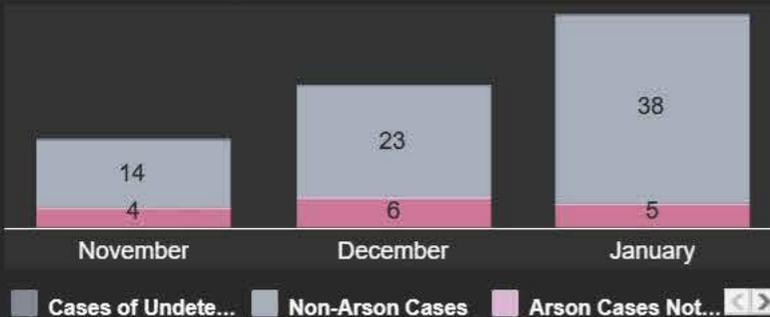

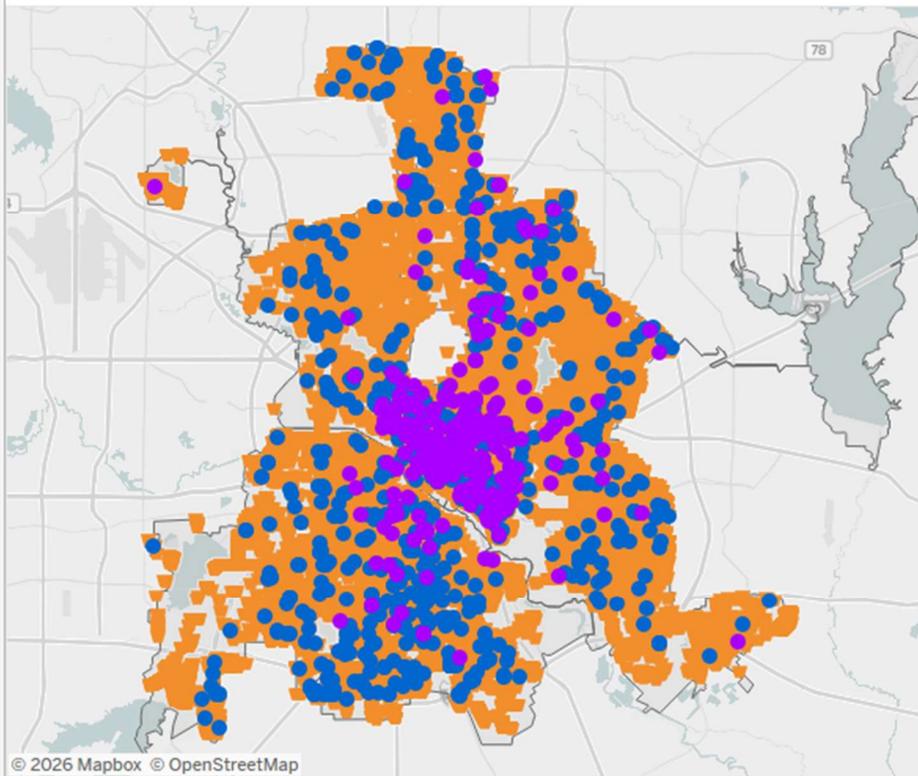

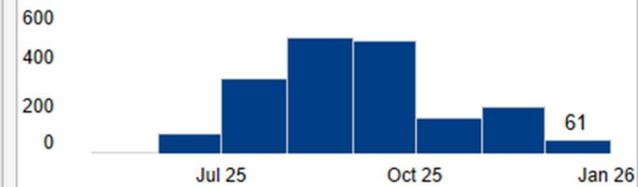
Service Divisions Map

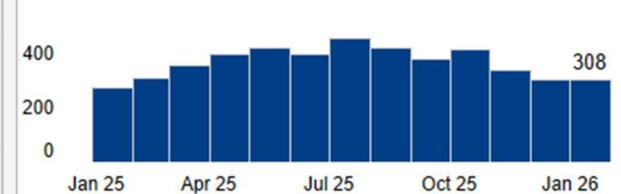

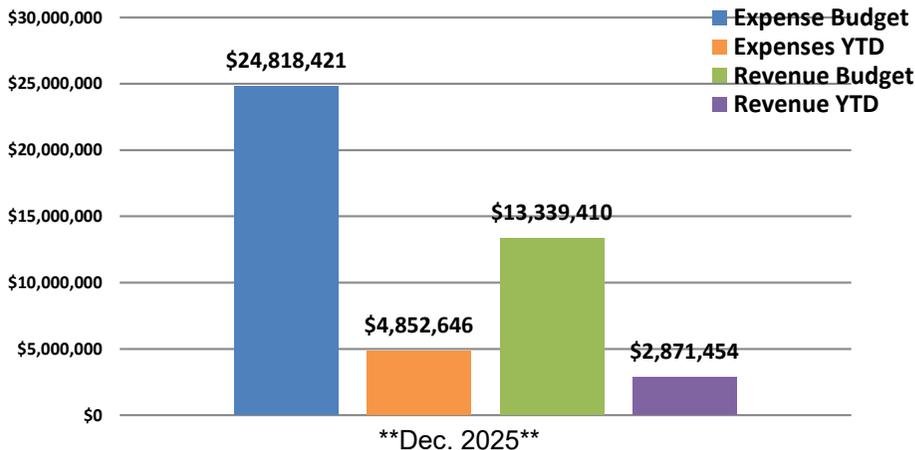

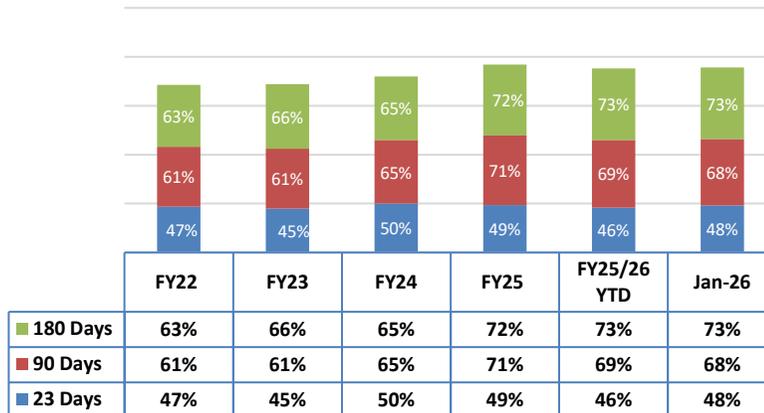


Dallas Municipal Court and Dallas Marshals Office: Month Ending January 2026

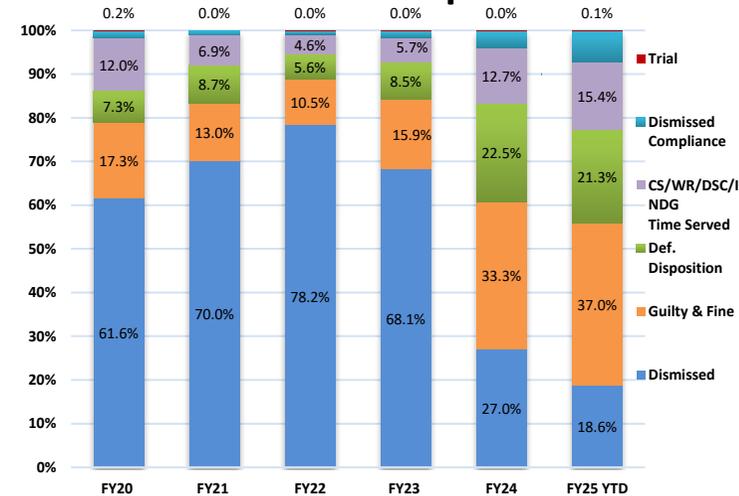
Municipal Court Budget



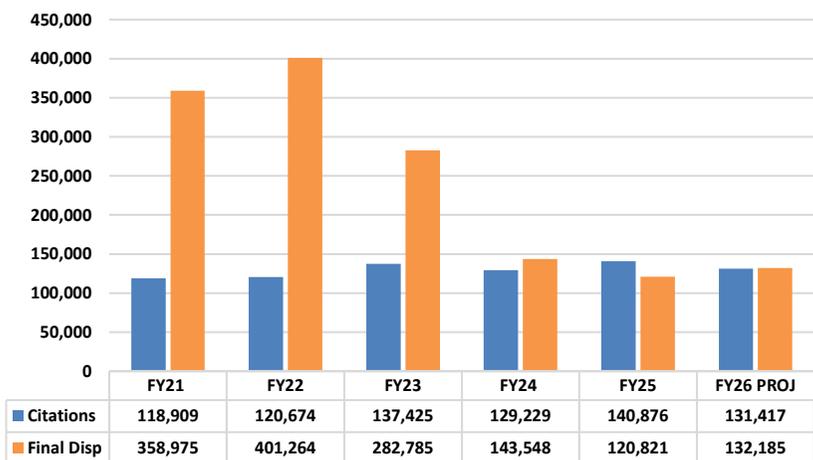
Defendant's Cumulative Response Rate Looking Back 23, 90 & 180 Days



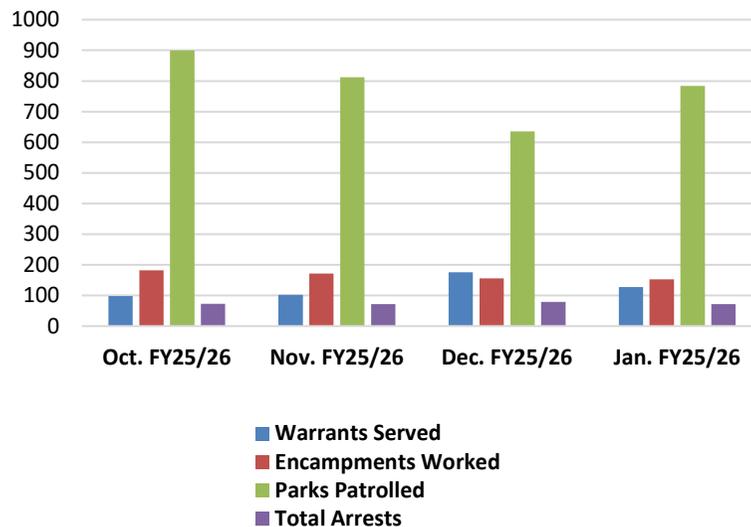
Courthouse Dispositions



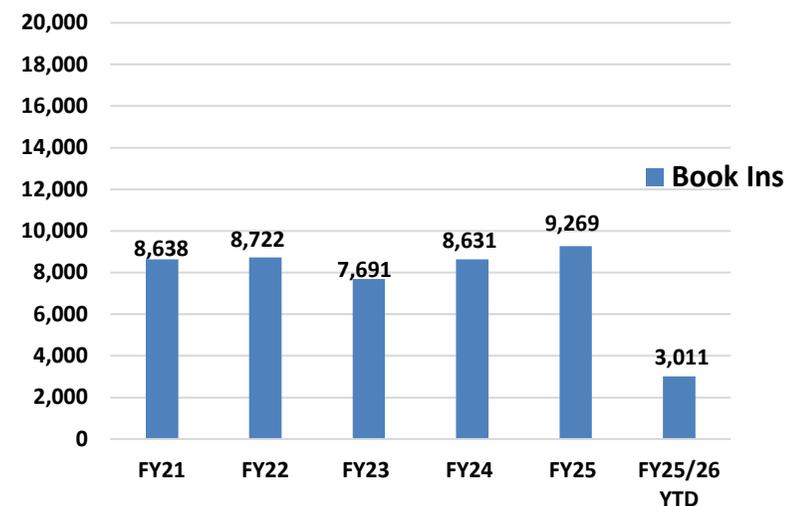
Citation Count & Final Dispositions



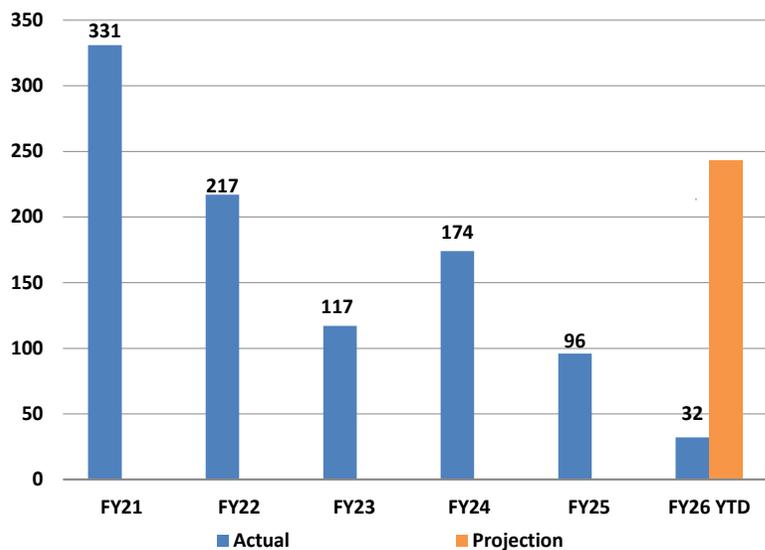

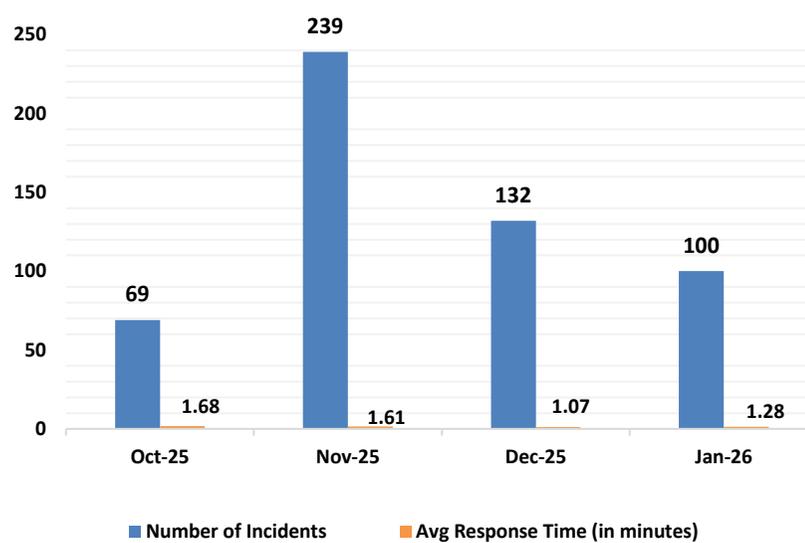

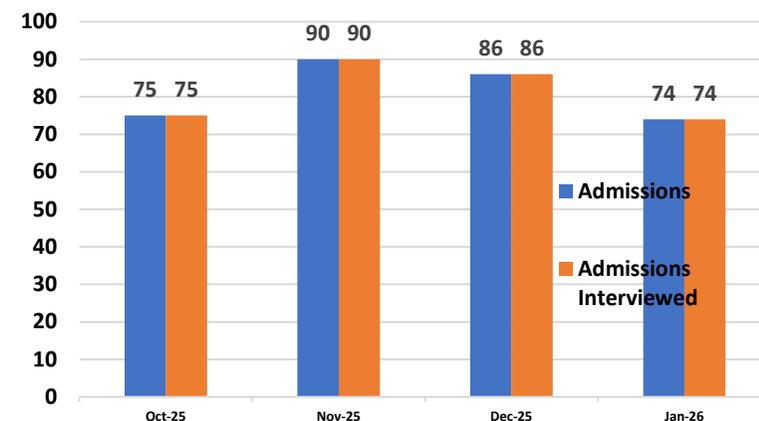
