

### LAUNCHING DTFC

On May 9th, 2O24, two days Following the Dallas City Council Vote, Dallas Trinity FC was born in a city-wide celebration at Klyde Warren Park that included remarks from Dallas Mayor Eric Johnson, Super League President Amanda Vandervort and earned a media reach of 74.1 million people and a Total Media Value of \$221K.

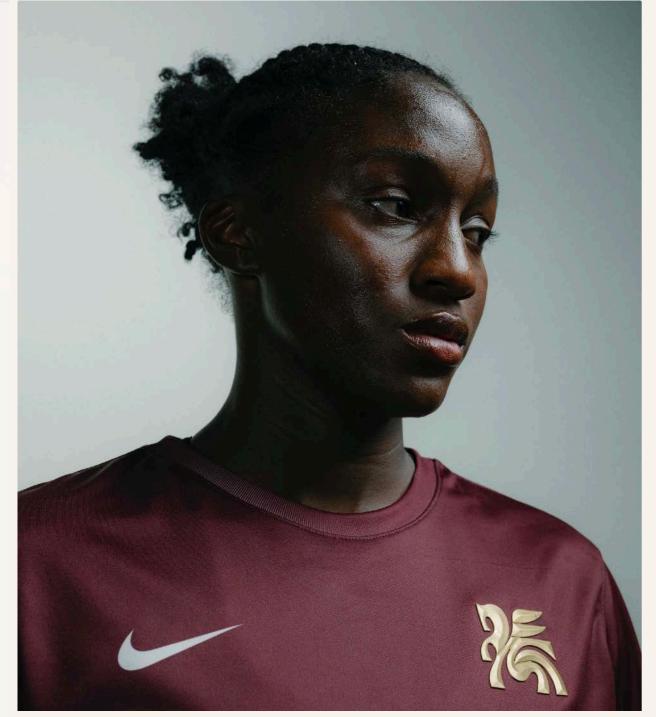




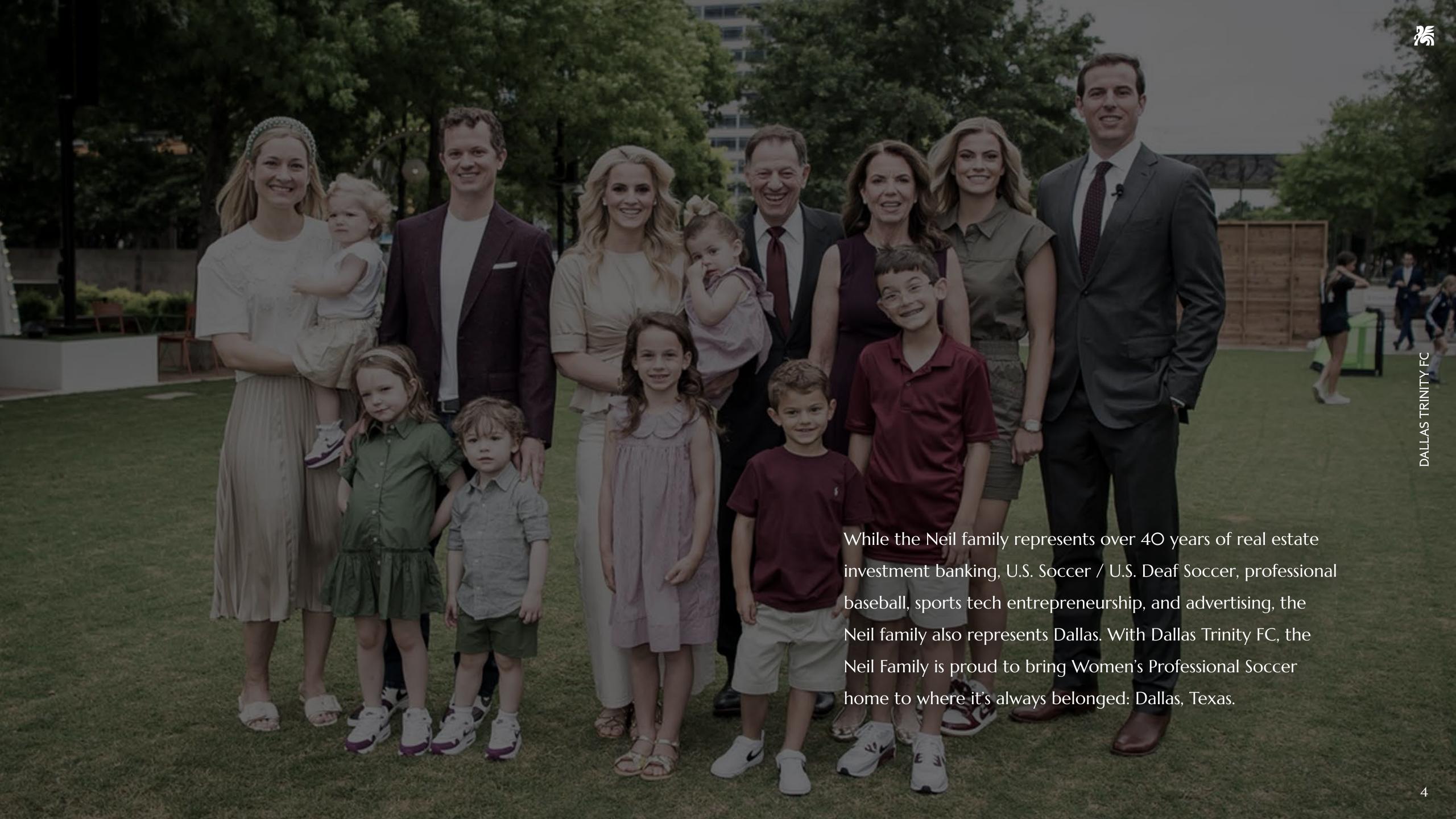

A forward from San Juan SC (ECNL) in Sacramento, Rhea Moore is a standout finisher and rising star. A regular selection for U.S. Youth National Team camps, Rhea was called into both U-16 and U-17 WYNT training camps in early 2O25. She also earned a spot on the ODP National Select Team in 2O23, showcasing her elite status among her peers.

At just 15 years and 332 days old, the Sacramento native scored in her professional debut against Sporting JAX on Sept. 6, 2O25, becoming the youngest goalscorer in any women's professional match in the United States and in the Gainbridge Super League.

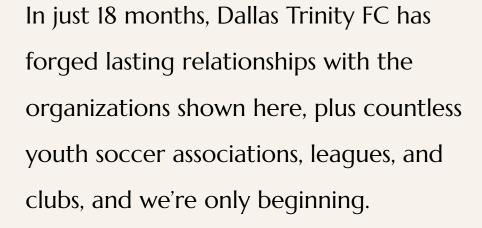
































































### HISTORY MADE

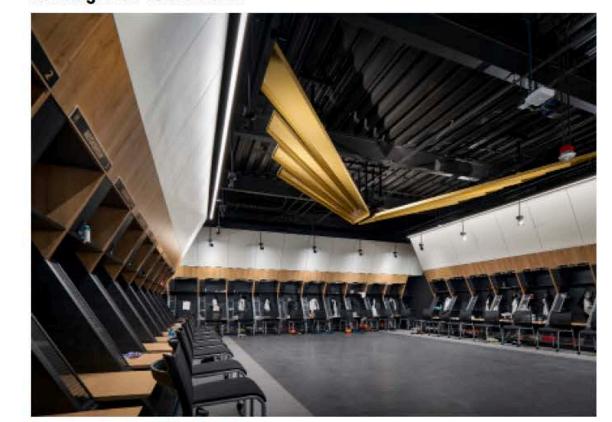
