Funeral services for Dallas Police Officer Rogelio Santander Jr. #10934, will be held on Tuesday, May 1, 2018, 11:00 a.m. at Lake Pointe Church (701 East I-30, Rockwall). A burial service will follow in the Garden of Honor at Restland Cemetery (13005 Greenville Ave, Dallas).

A private mass will be held on Monday, April 30, 2018, 2:00 p.m. at the Cathedral Guadalupe (2215 Ross Avenue, Dallas). A public visitation will be held the same day, from 6-9:00pm, at the cathedral. Arrangements are being handled by Restland Funeral Home (13005 Greenville Avenue, Dallas).

Council and staff transportation is being coordinated for the funeral service.

Officer Rogelio Santander Jr., was shot in the line of duty on Tuesday, April 24, 2018, and passed away the following morning. Officer Santander was assigned to the Northeast Patrol Division. He was 27 years old and had three years of service.
