Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for South Dallas Fair Park Opportunity SUBJECT Fund Human Development Grants

In conformance with the South Dallas Fair Park Opportunity Fund (SDFPOF) Program Statement approved by City Council on June 27, 2018 as Resolution No. 18-0923, up to \$100,000 is available annually for human development grants in the SDFPOF service area.
