SUBJECT **Atmos Energy Corporation - DARR Filing**

On January 15, Atmos Energy Corporation, Mid-Tex Division (Atmos) filed a request with the City to increase rates. This filing was made under the Dallas Annual Rate Review (DARR) Tariff and is the company's eighth filing under the current DARR mechanism. Atmos is requesting an increase in annual revenues of \$38,138,856 from within the city. This represents a monthly increase of 10.51% or \$11.25 per month (\$135.00 per year) for the average residential customer. Atmos has requested a June 1, 2026, effective date for the new rates.

Staff is currently reviewing the filing with the City's gas rate consultant and outside legal counsel and will brief their findings to the Finance Committee on May 26, 2026, with recommendations for Council action on May 27, 2026. The statutory deadline to take action on this matter is May 30, 2026.
