



5. I am a busy physician, but make a point to reach out to my neighbors and interact with the local community. I have responded to many questions and taken issues back to the DCMSA from members of the Historic District, and also from people outside the SAHD.

As a physician who currently practices medicine in the City of Dallas, a member the Dallas County Medical Society and DSMSA, and a resident of the Swiss Avenue Historic District, I support and agree with the current use of the Aldredge House as the foundation and cornerstone for all that the DCMSA does for the community. The DCMSA partners with the Dallas County Medical Society to provide programs of health education, health awareness, and philanthropy throughout Dallas County. The DCMSA has a long history of helping the community alongside the physicians in Dallas, including assisting with providing medical care, physical exams, vaccines and bicycle helmets to the underserved in Dallas County. The DCMSA also provides annual scholarships to young people in need, predominantly those pursuing nursing and other medical careers.

7. The DCMSA has every intention to be good neighbors within the SAHD. They appointed me liaison two and a half years ago to help keep the lines of communication open between the neighbors on Swiss Avenue and the DCMSA.

8. The DCMSA employs Adam Palmer as the Caretaker of the Aldredge House. Adam is available on a daily basis to assist with daily maintenance issues at the house. Adam keeps an eye on the neighborhood and thwarts possible crimes; he has a great rapport with the local police patrols.
