CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME/INVOCATION

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

SPECIAL EVENTS

A. MLK Dallas Toastmasters

Ms. Jones reported that the MLK Dallas Toastmaster Club is an official charter now and is taking members. The club meets on the first and third Thursday of each month at 6:30pm-7:30pm.

B. Christmas Toy Drive

Ms. Jones reported that sign up for the Christmas Toy project has officially closed. The disbursement dates for those that signed up and were approved through the program will be Tuesday 12/20/16 and Wednesday12/21/16. Each approved recipient has been notified and

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given a specific pickup date and time. There will be a walk-in on Thursday 12/22/16 10:00am-2:00pm.

C. 35th Annual MLK Celebration

Ms. Jones reported that CW33 have officially confirmed that they will be a partner for this year's celebration. They will do a live stream and will provide the mistress or master of ceremony for the gala. They want to do more with us doing the year. The entertainment for this year will be Dillard University Choir, Candy West and the Ray Baker Project. It has also been requested that the new District Attorney Faith Johnson be the parade grand marshal for 2017, we are awaiting an answer from her office. We have requested and awaiting the answer from the Mayor's office regarding the title sponsor.

D. Black History Month

Ms. Jones reported that we will have a program on Thursday, February 23, 2017. It will honor influential black women that are leaders here in the Dallas area. We have not started any contact with anyone but we will keep you notified of the program.

E. AIDS South Dallas Walk

Ms. Jones reported that this is a partnership with the community group and it will be there second year having it at the center. The dates have not been confirmed but it will either be the second or third Saturday in the month of March. We will notify you once all agendas have been confirmed.
