Woods/Sugarberry has approx. 1,500 households(70% home ownerships and 30% renters).

Our Crime Watch/HOA averages approx. 17 to 35 at a regular meeting on 3rd Tuesday Night at Park in the Woods

Recommendations:

1. Council pay. Raise to 50,000 to 60,000 ^{years} ~~monthly~~
2. Length of term for mayor and city council should remain the same ...
3. Keep the City manager form of government
4. Add a quarterly official city evening council meeting
